Who's Afraid of the Big Bad Wolf?







The 2000 Thayer Volleyball Team had a dominating season leading them to state. The Lady Flyers had an awesome season, ending with a Varsity record of 29-8, and a JV record of 10-2. The Lady Flyers had many accomplishments this year, taking: first in the Cherryvale Tournament, first in the Thayer Quad, third in the MBL League, Regional Champions, Sub-State Champions, and the best for last- State Qualifiers (1 of the top eight 1A teams in Kansas).

Their Regional record was Thayer vs. Chetopa 15-0 and 15-8; Thayer vs. LeRoy 15-5 and 15-7. The Sub-State record was Thayer vs. Flinthills15-9, 14-16, and 15-17. Championship game Lady Flyers defeated Lebo 15-7, 11-15, and 16-14, to go on to the State games.

The Lady Flyers ended their season as one of the top eight 1A teams in Kansas. Receiving All-League honors were Katie Brant, Amanda Fogleman, and receiving honorable mention was Kara Stafford. The Lady Flyers JV team consisted of Erika Ellis, Jessica Houston, Brooke Madl, and April Novotny.




