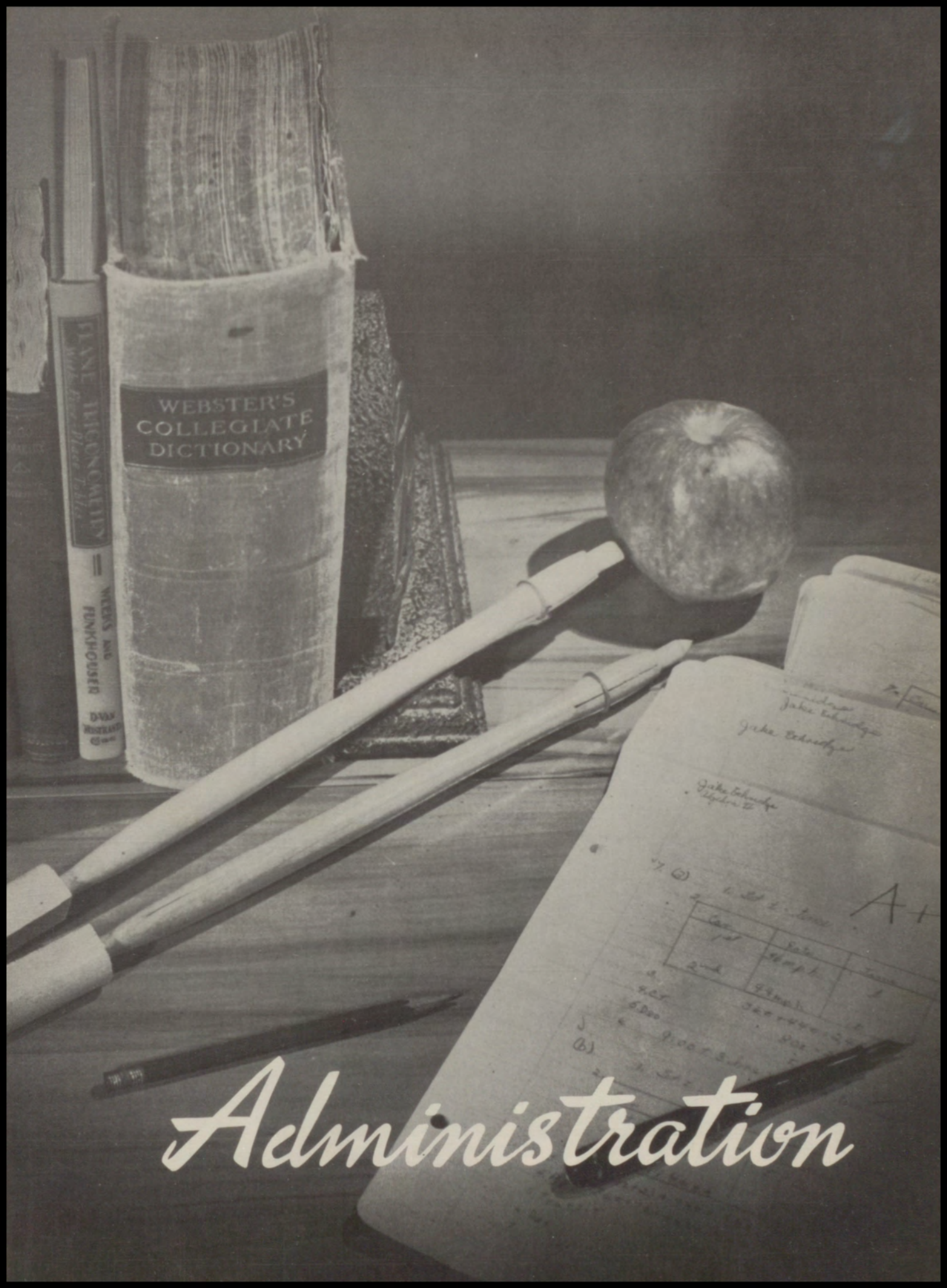


## *Dedication*

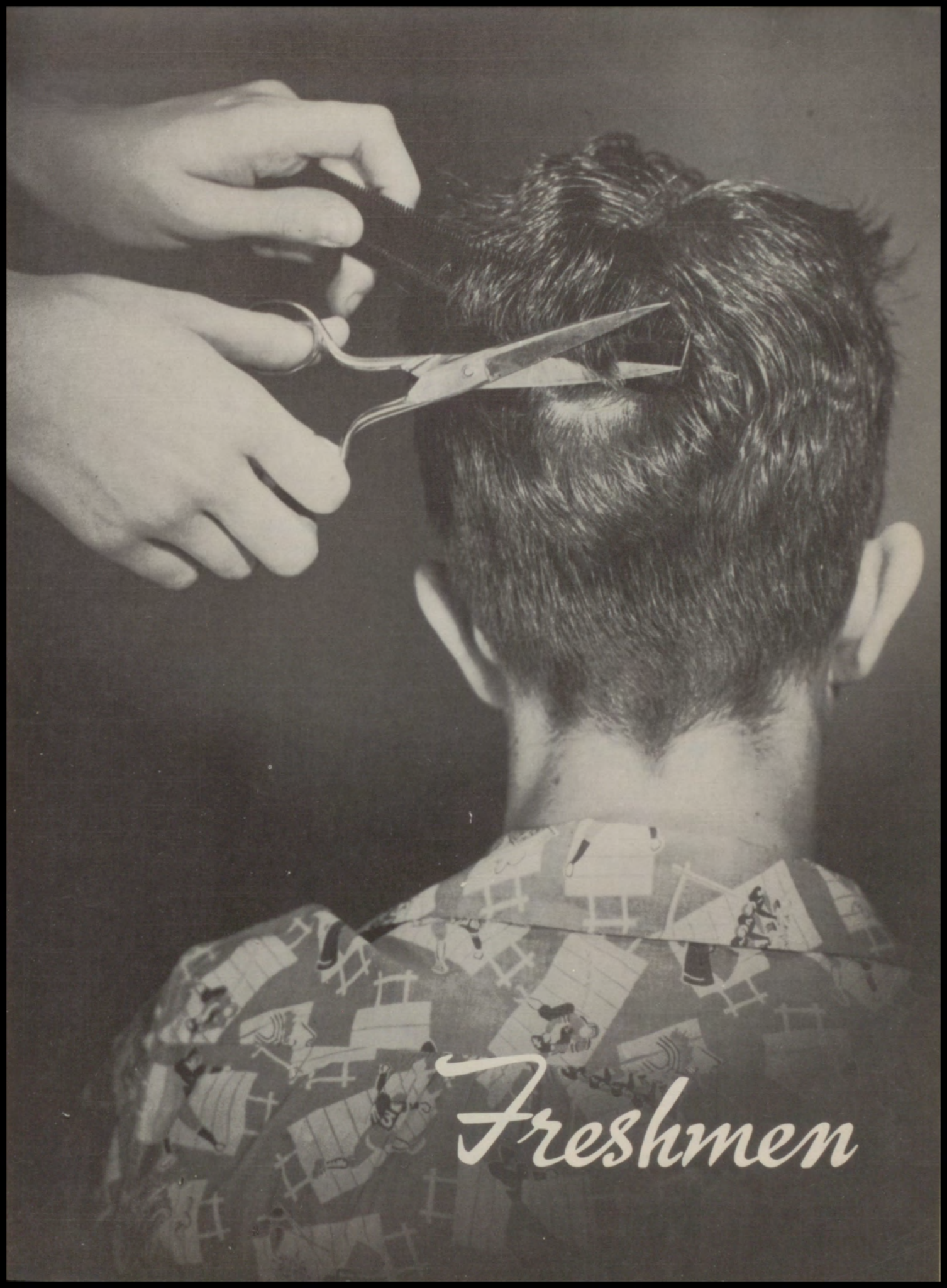

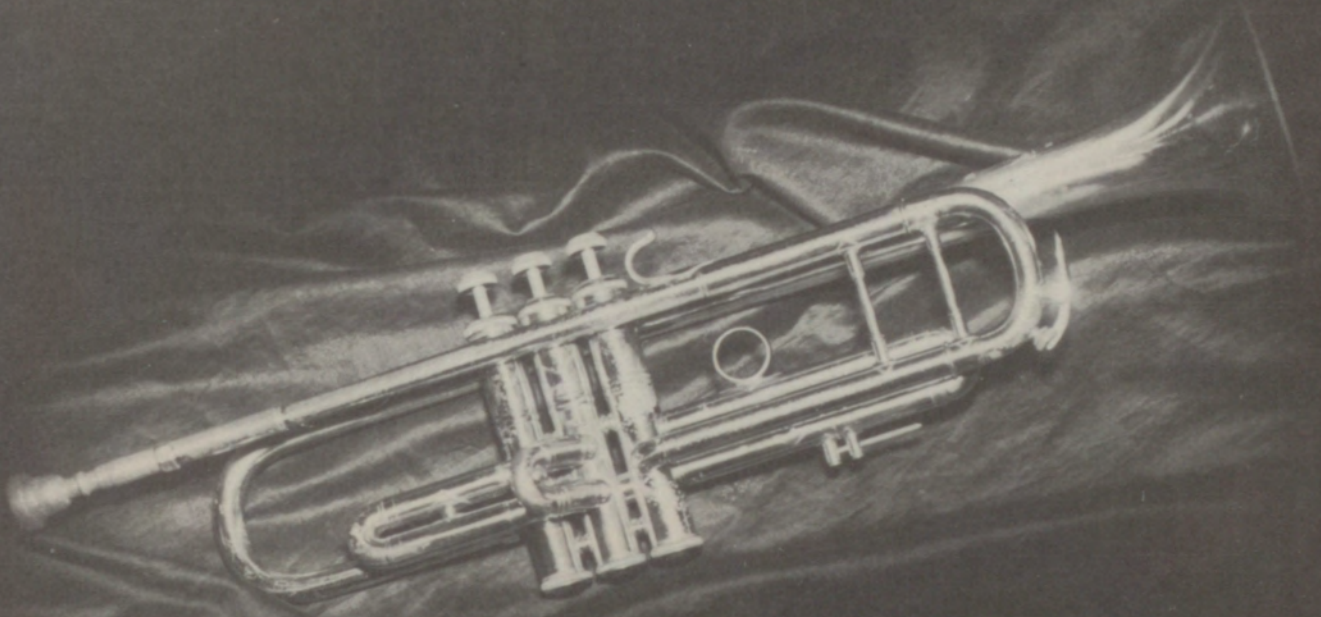
