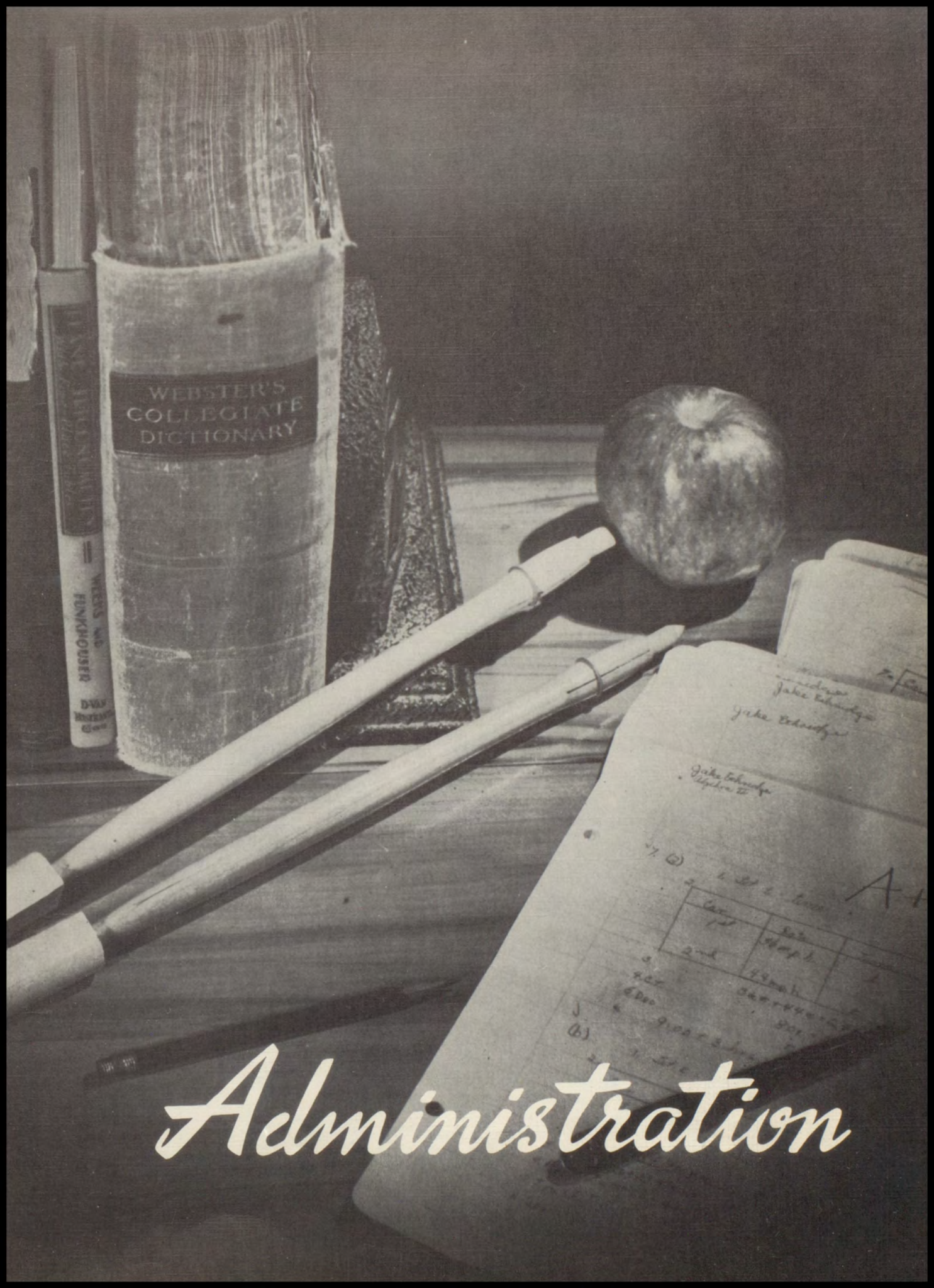
Dedication
