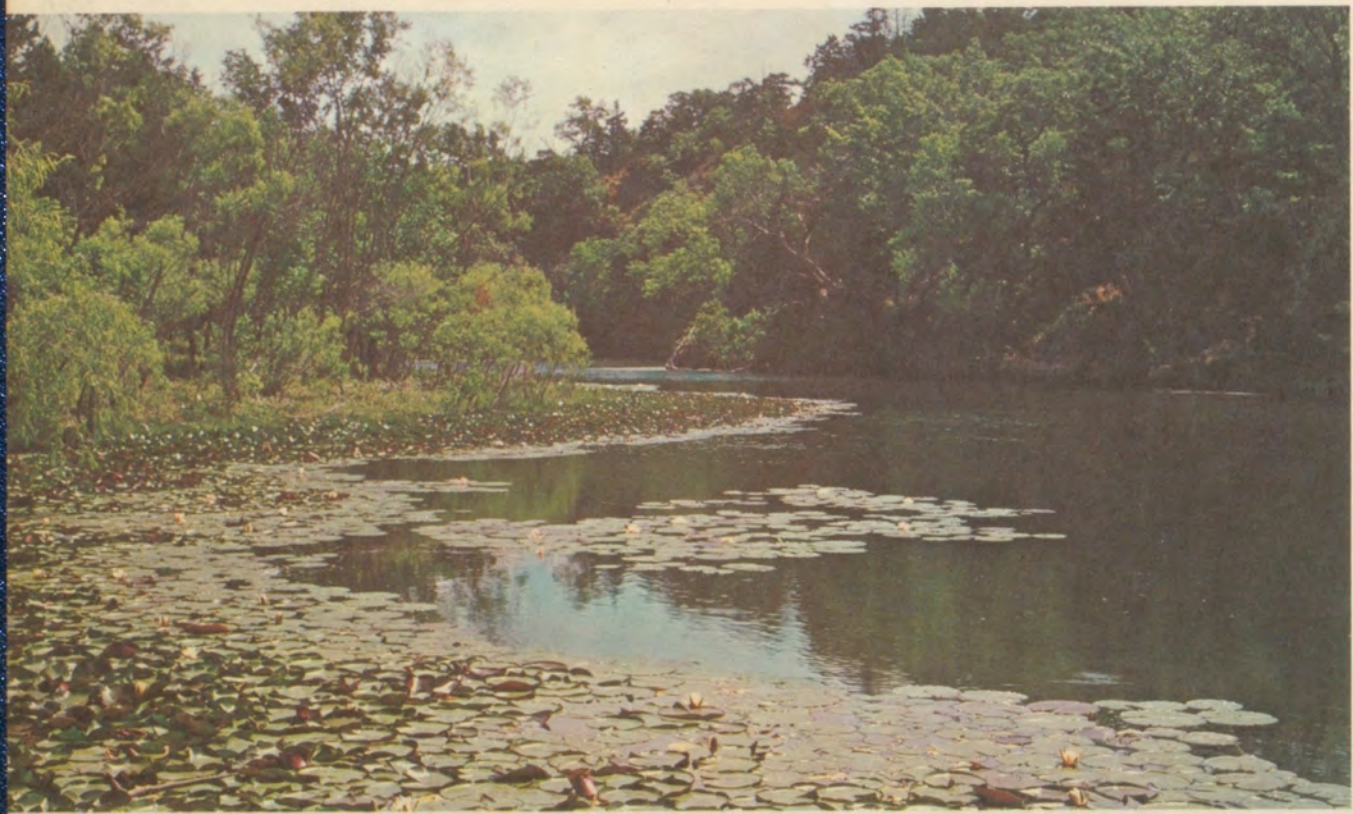
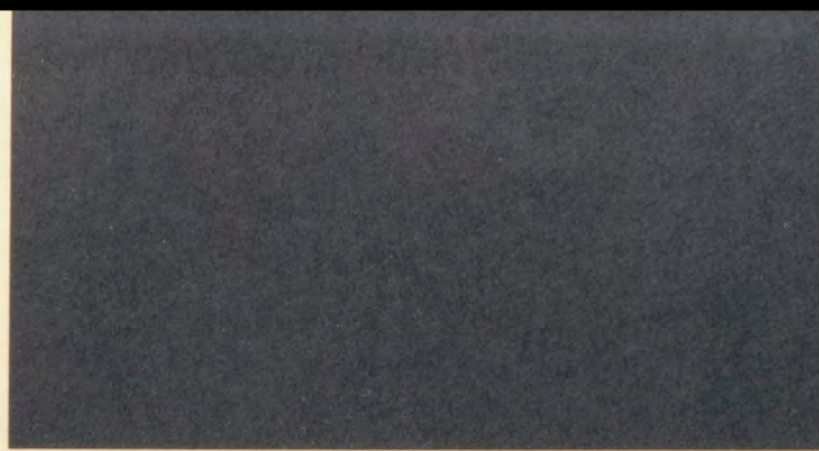


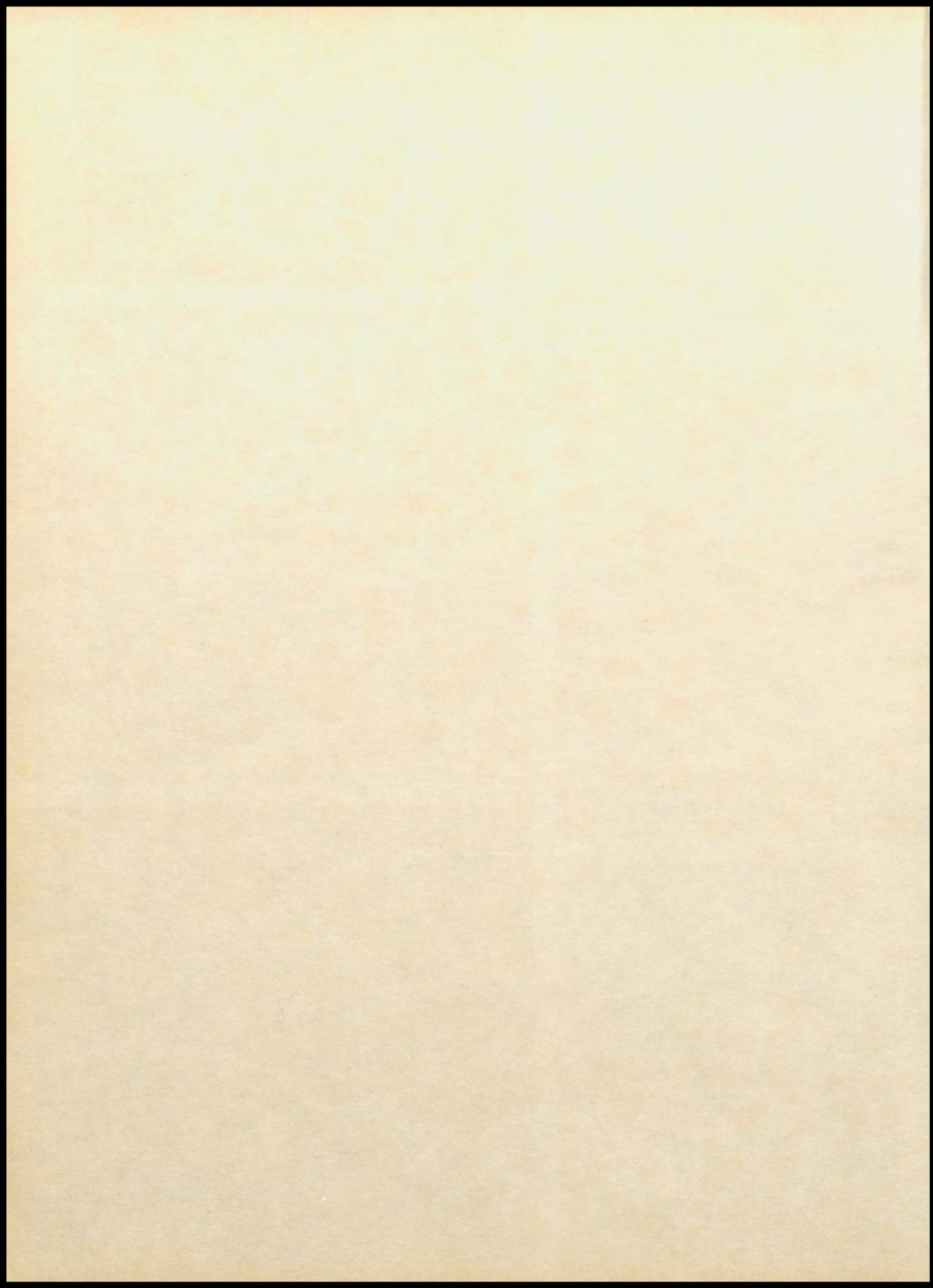

Together we have experienced and shared our joys in the class rooms, hall ways and athletic events.

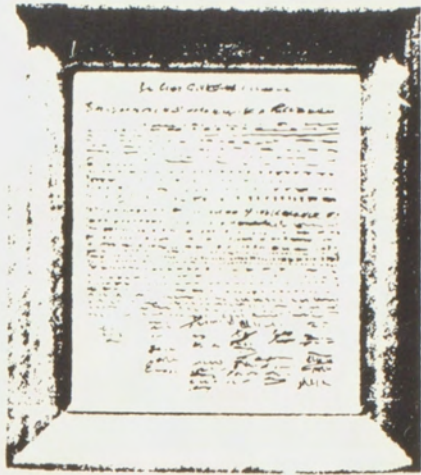
But as we look back, our parting leaves us with many happy moments, for life does have its ways of separating us from our fondest memories.
