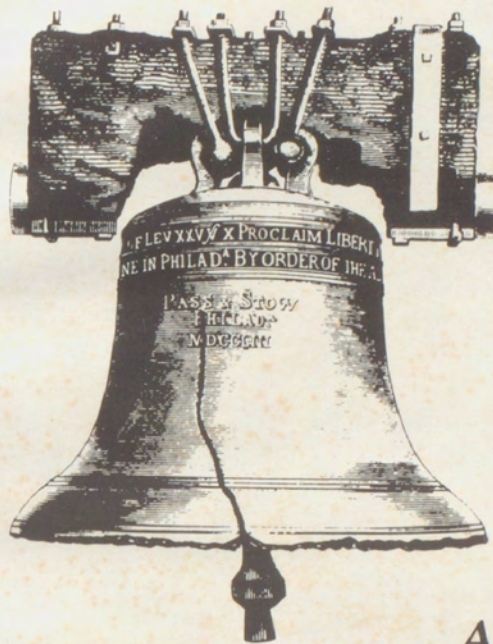

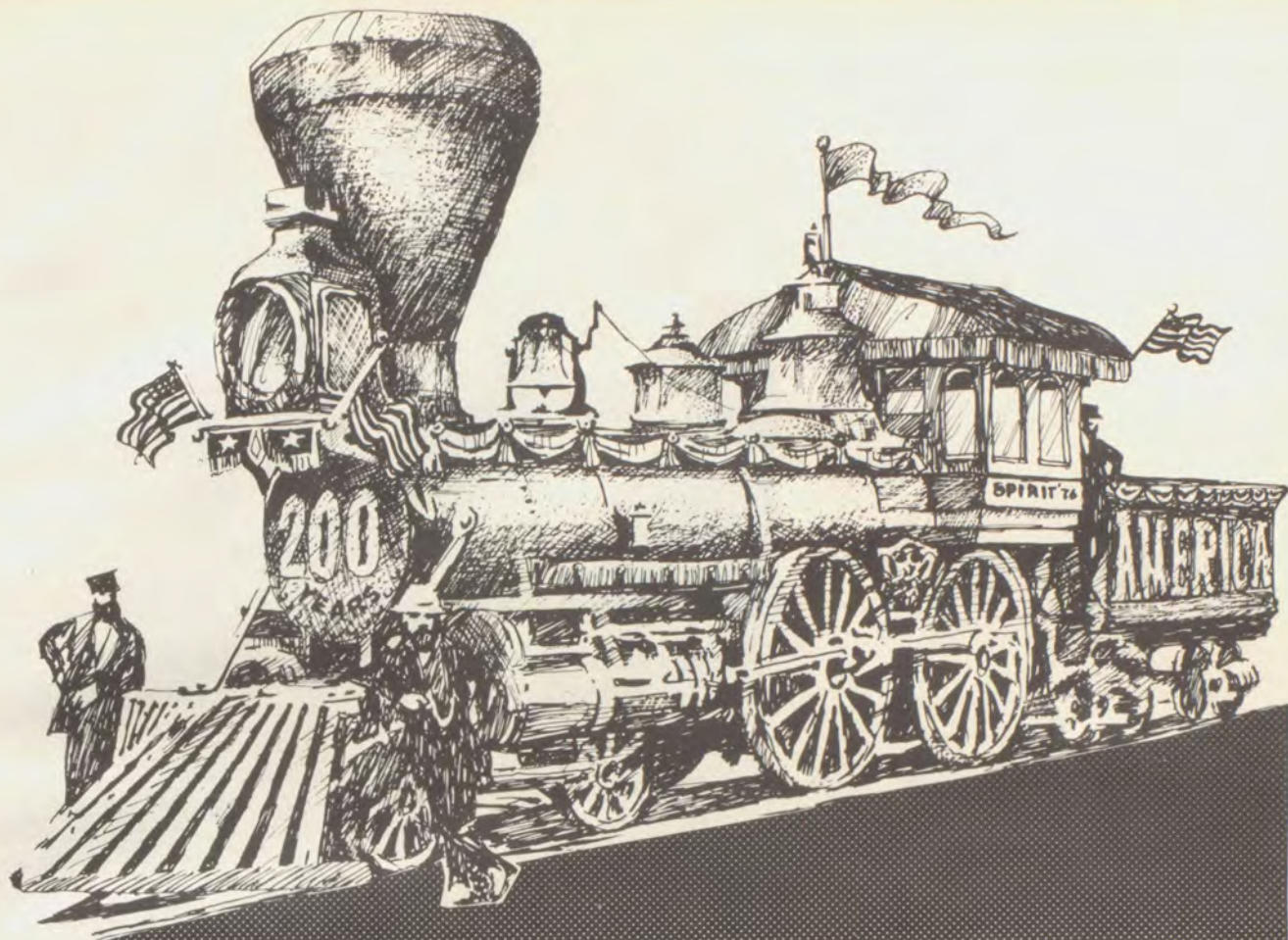
## *Dedication*
