"This is the best team I've ever had," said Eagle coach Tom Stewart, who is in his sixth season as head coach.

Playing a major role in Lenapah's success this season has been 5-foot-10 senior Sara Turney. The team's leading scorer, Turney is averaging 35.8 points per game.

Also starting on the offensive end are 5-7 sophomore Lynn Voyles, a 12 ppg scorer, 5-8 senior Kelly King, 5 ppg, and 5-4 sophomore Roz Matthews, 3 ppg.

Manning the often-unheralded defensive positions are 5-8 senior Traci Porter, the conference's defensive player of the year last season, 5-9 senior Leigh Gillespie, and 5-4 sophomore Angie Ross.

"These girls don't get a whole lot of recognition because of our half-court rules," said Stewart. "But they have been outstanding all season long. They are very dedicated. If they don't play well, we don't win."

"Traci is our most steady and consistent defensive player and our team leader in rebounds; Leigh is a three-year starter; and Angie is our leader in steals and is a very talented player."
