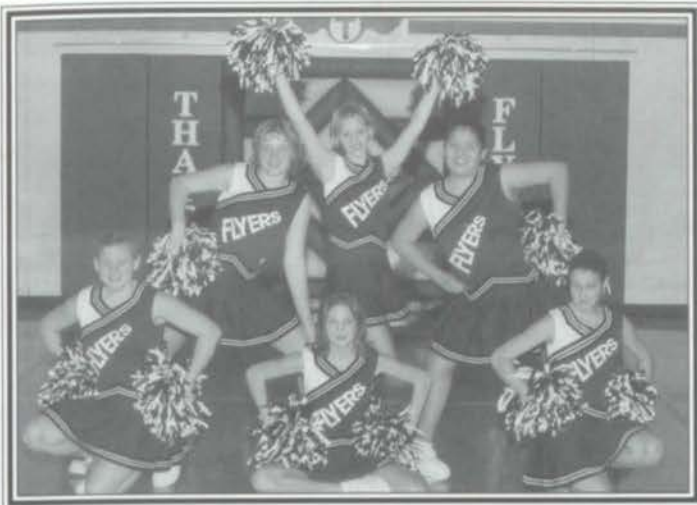
## County Spelling Bee Champion Brian Powers

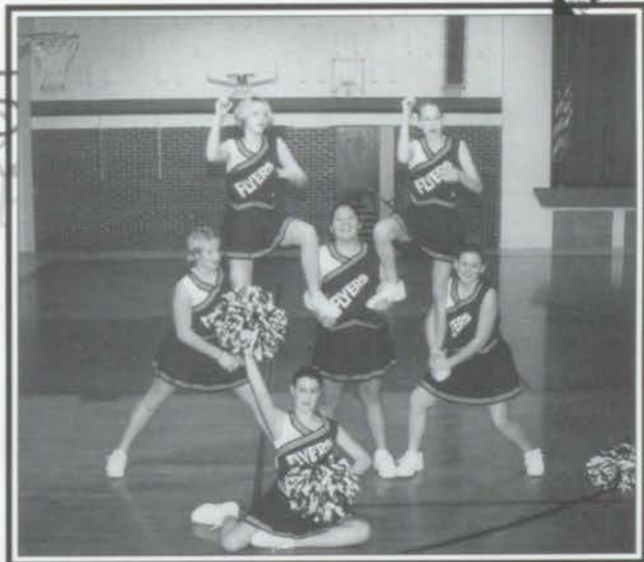

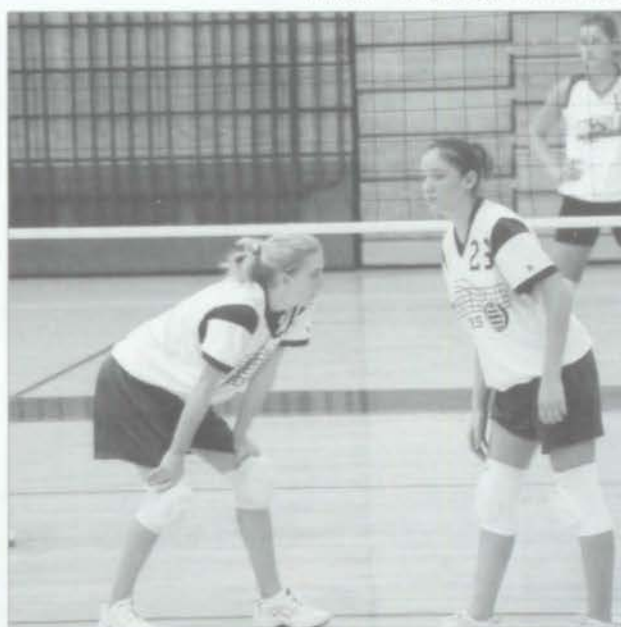

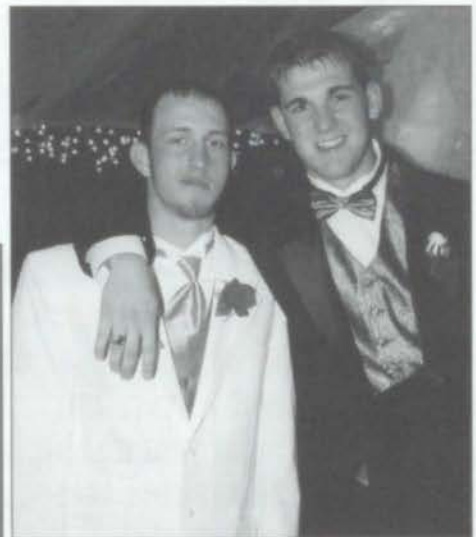
