



#### **AROUND THE LIBRARY**

#### **3rd Floor Stories**

Families have been having a blast every Tuesday from 10:15 to 11:00 AM at "Family Storytime Adventures" this summer. Each week we start with a welcoming energetic song, listen to a themed story, STEM group activity or felt board story, egg shaker songs, hands-on STEM related activity table, and craft themed arts table. In the pictures above, children were learning about the Sun, so at activity tables, they engineered UV bracelets, and practiced their cutting skills making the sun rays for their Sun craft. Another "Family Storytime Adventure," the theme of the day was 'Aliens'. At the STEM table, they had to engineer an alien out of Playdough! Their creations are still on display in the library. Throughout the summer, the children learned about the universe, stars, nighttime, Moon, becoming a reader, aliens, constellations, Sun, and rockets. While the activities are themed for children, adults join in on the songs, games, or helping with the activity. For instance, during the Moon storytime, children threw 'aluminum foil asteroids' in a moon bucket, and

adults helped keep the kids in line. The activities, songs, crafts, storytelling, and more are a great way to spend time with your kids and help them develop a lifelong love of reading which will foster early literacy skills.
