- Scene 7. The garden of Nonnberg Abbey, that night.

The Story



Set in Salzburg, Austria "The Sound of Music" tells the story of a well-to-do family which was forced to flee their homeland after Hitler's invasion in 1938. The family escaped to America and later became famous as the Trapp Family Singers.

The play deals with the von Trapp family prior to its departure from Austria. Captain Georg von Trapp, a naval hero held in high esteem by his countrymen, is a strict disciplinarian with his seven motherless children. Because the children remind him so much of his late wife, the Captain is given to taking long visits to Vienna to be with friends. He is forced to return home frequently, however, because of his children's knack for getting rid of their governesses.

Maria Rainer, a fun-loving young postulant at Nonnberg Abbey, is finally sent to the Trapp villa to take charge of the youngsters. Before she can take off her coat and hat, she clashes with the Captain on how to handle the children and it soon becomes apparent that the children's only aim is to rid themselves of another bothersome governess.

Keegan Reid - Friedrich

Fourteen year old Keegan is making his second appearance in a Neewollah production. He was Molly's youngest brother in "The Unsinkable Molly Brown" and appeared in the ICC productions "Oliver," and "Once Upon a Mattress." Keegan enjoys playing Dungeons and Dragons, an imaginary role playing game complete with collectibles. He is the son of John and Charlotte Reid. He has one brother, Tim, age 20.
