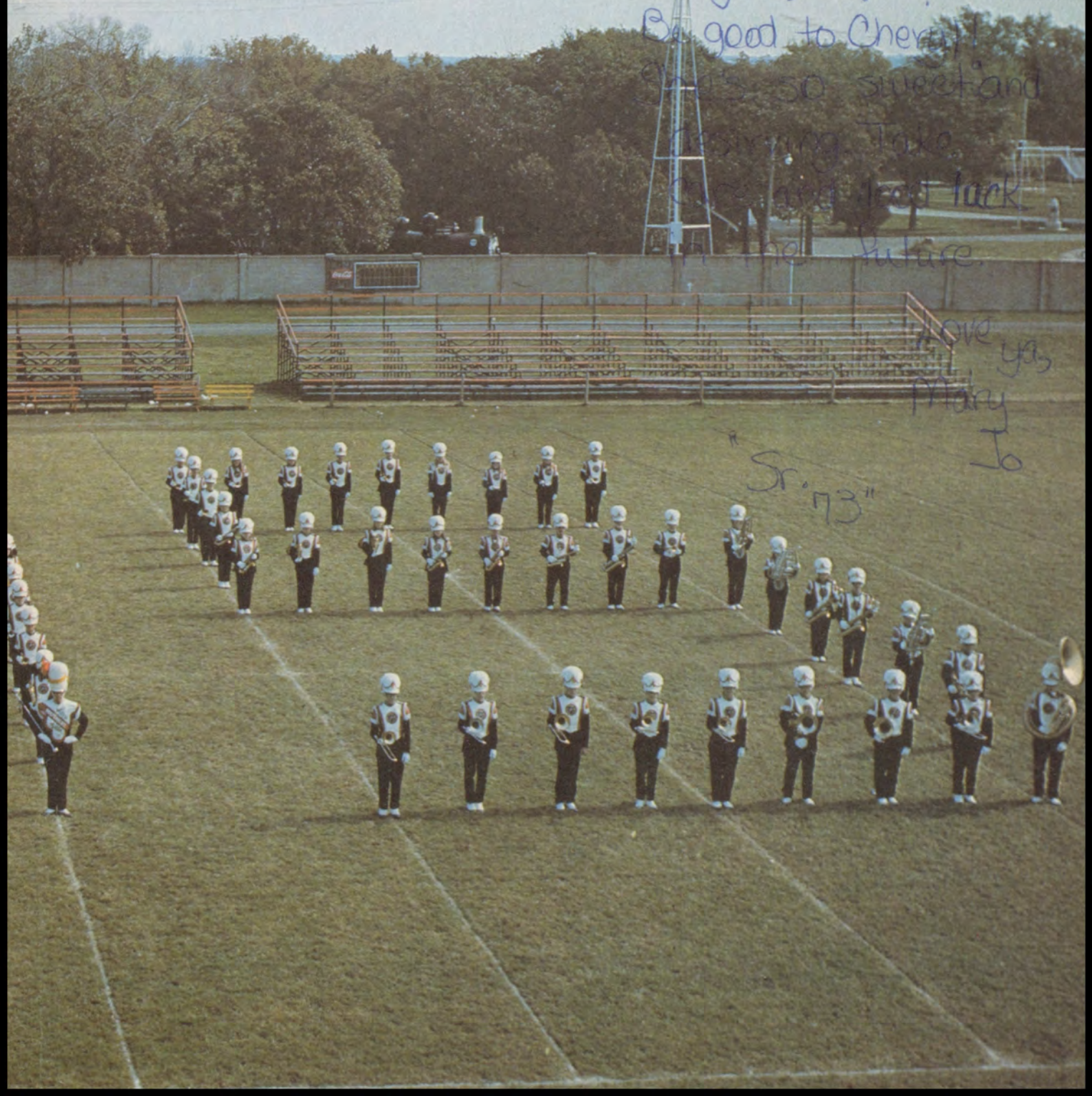

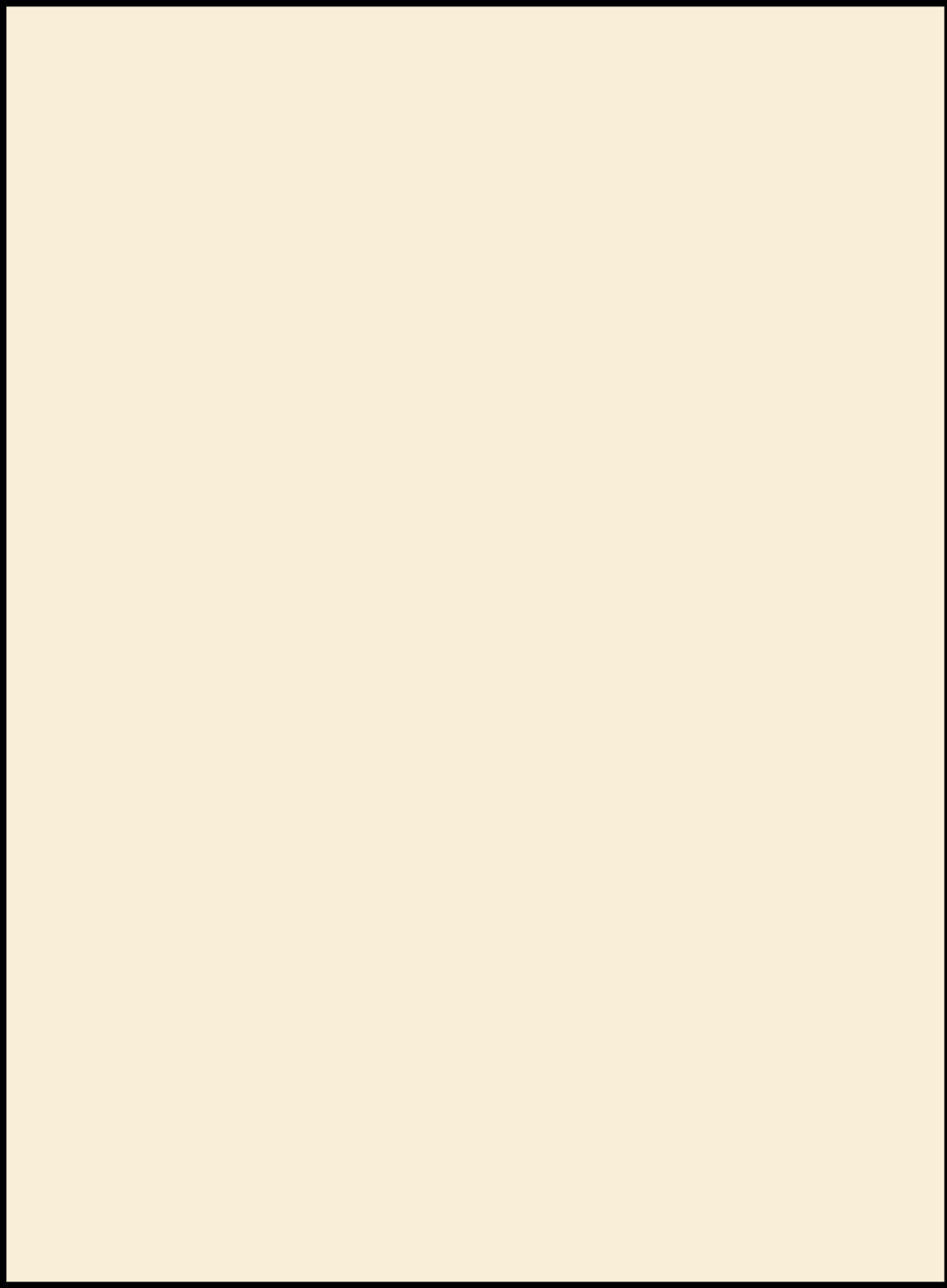

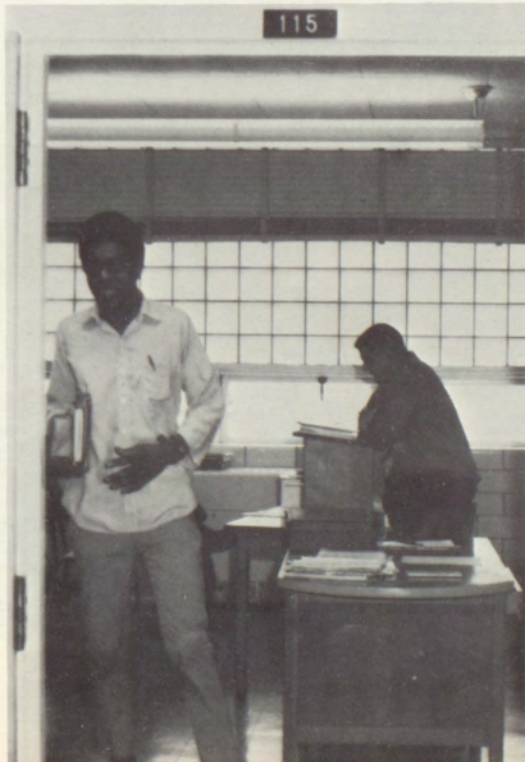


IT'S ALL OURS

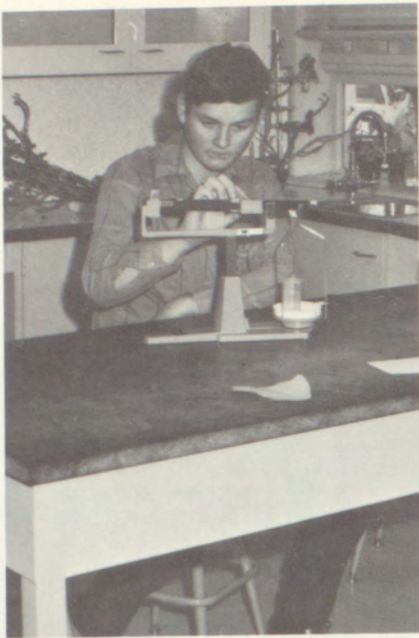


IT'S ALL OURS — TO EXPLORE

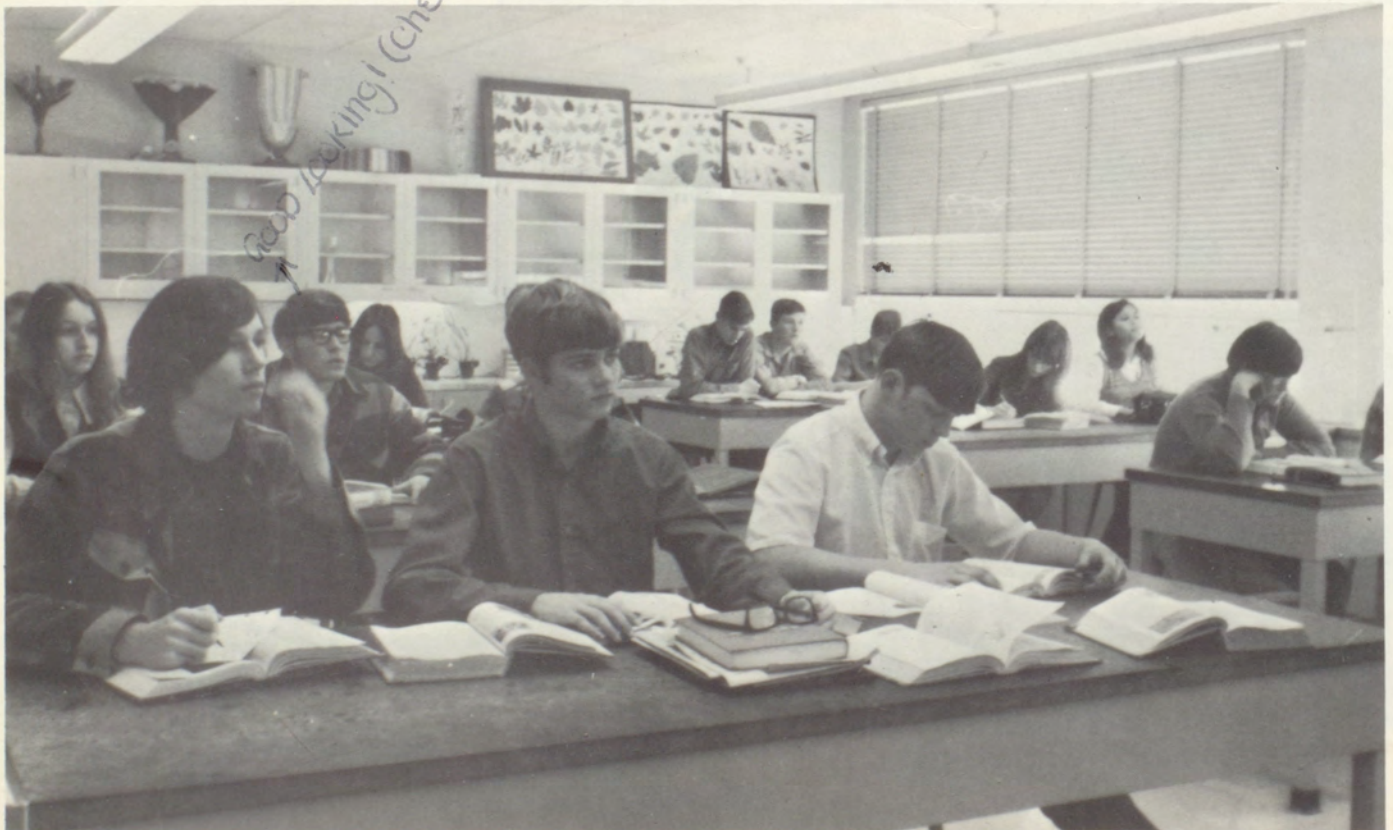


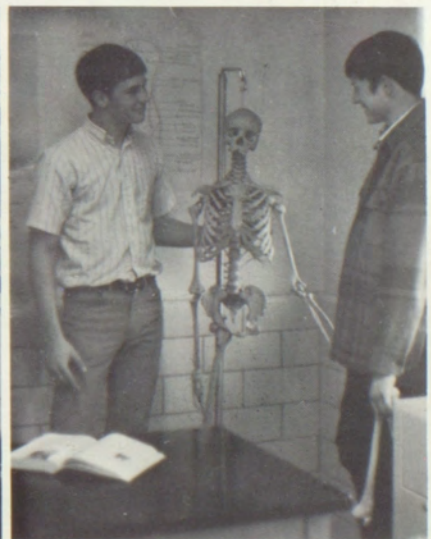
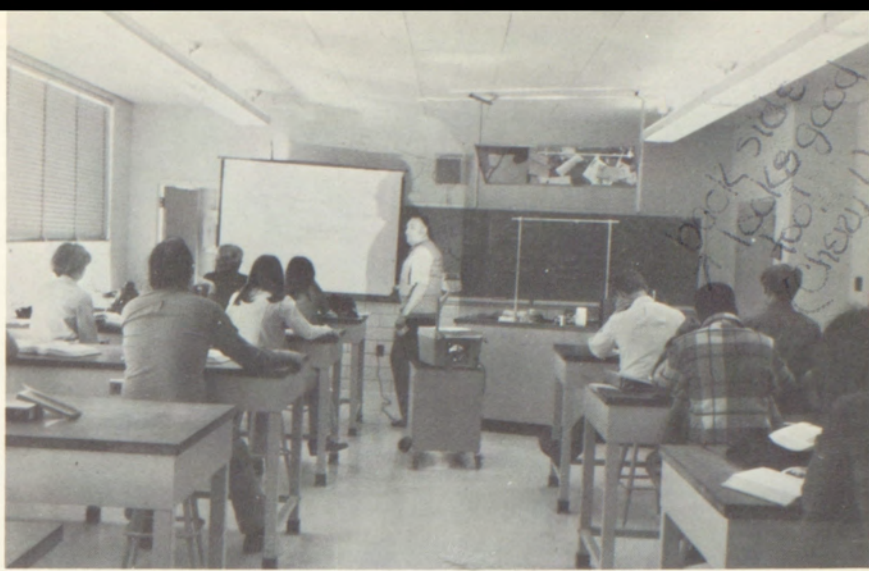




IT'S ALL OURS TO USE

Next year's prospects look brighter with 14 lettermen returning including 10 part time starters who were also the backbone of a 5 - 2 junior varsity season.

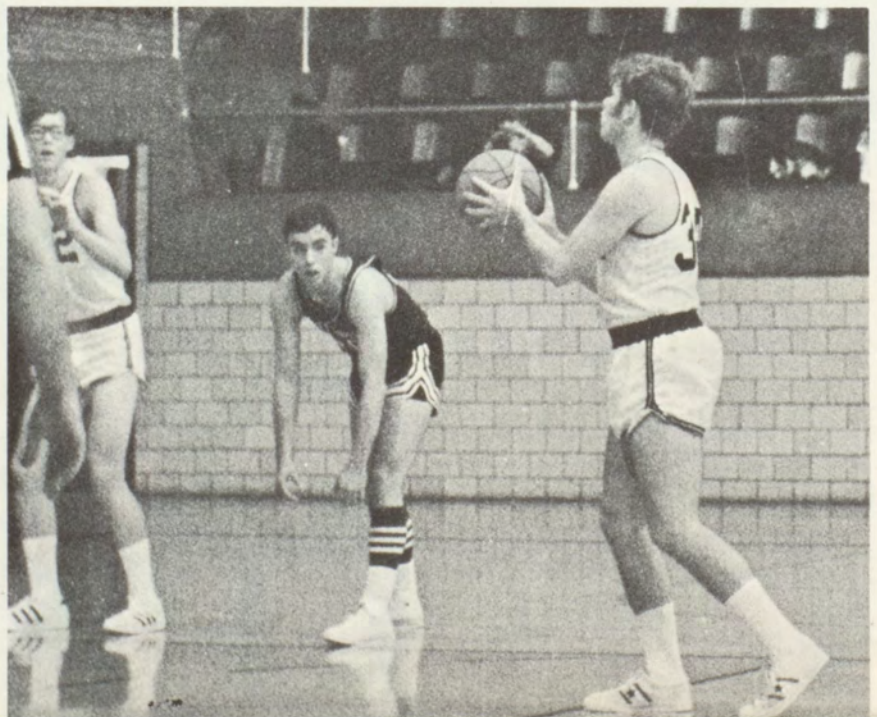
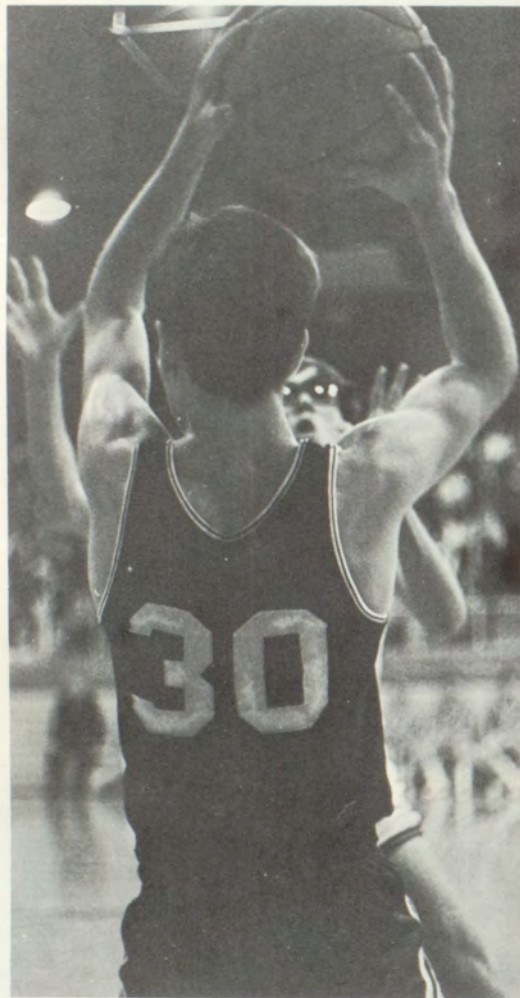

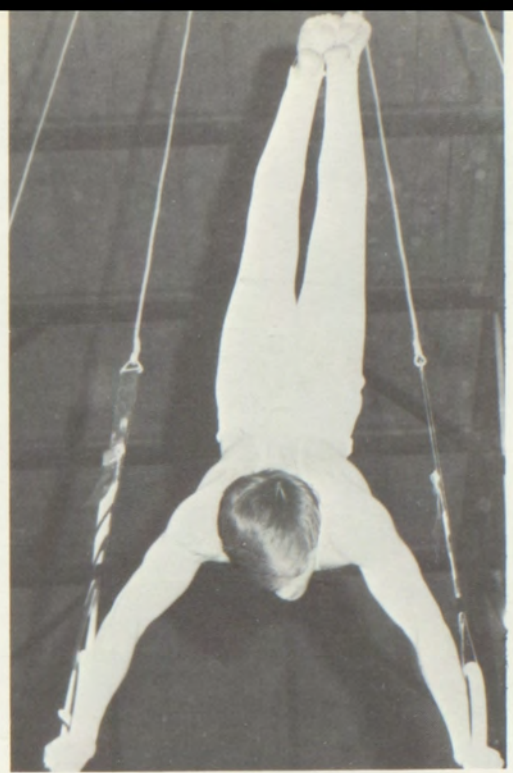

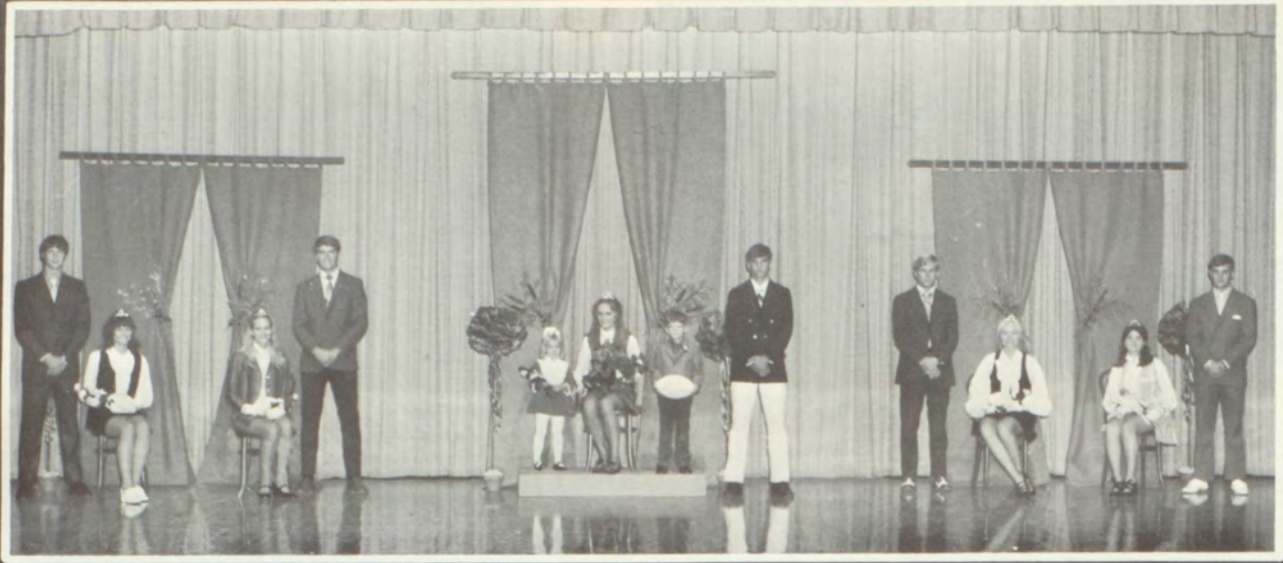

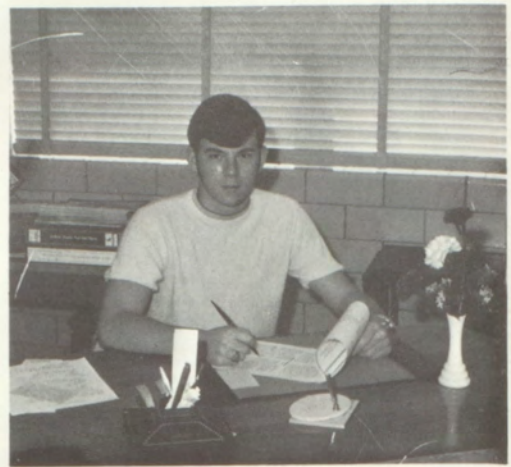
