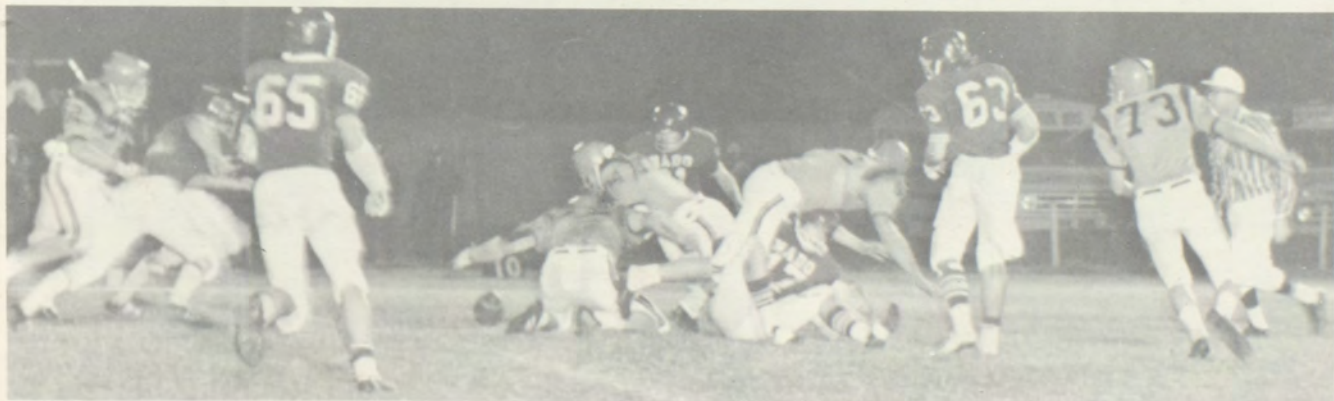


QUARTERBACK PETER REID LEADS OFFENSE IN ACTION AGAINST COLUMBUS.

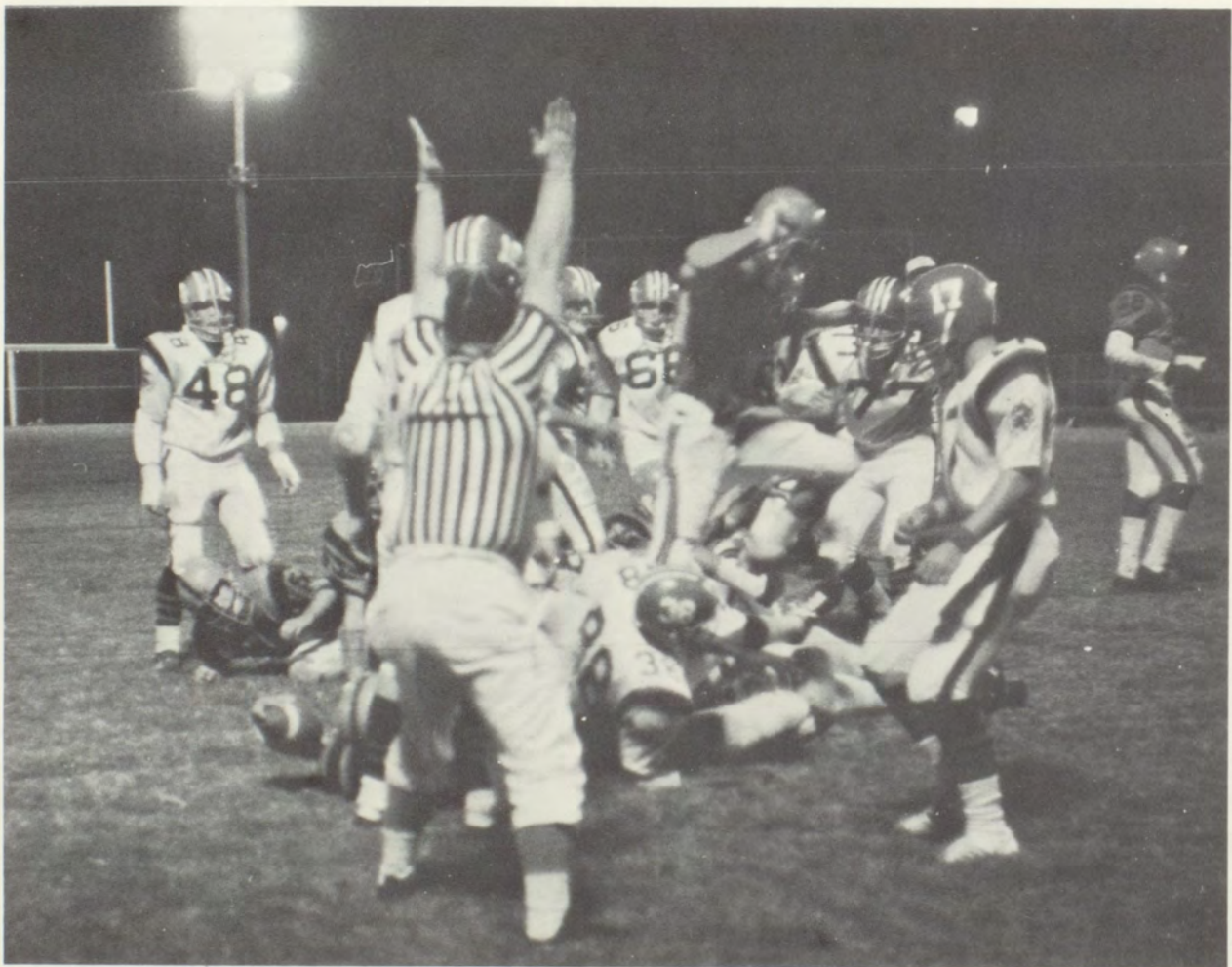

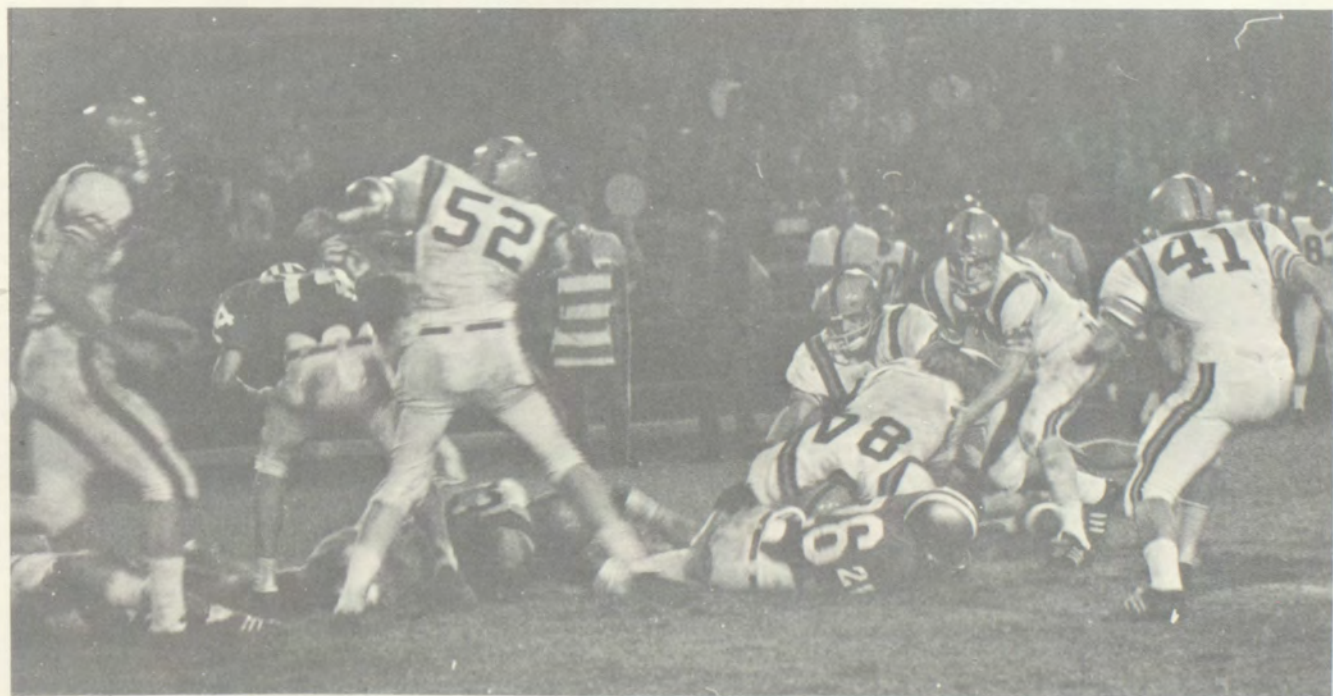


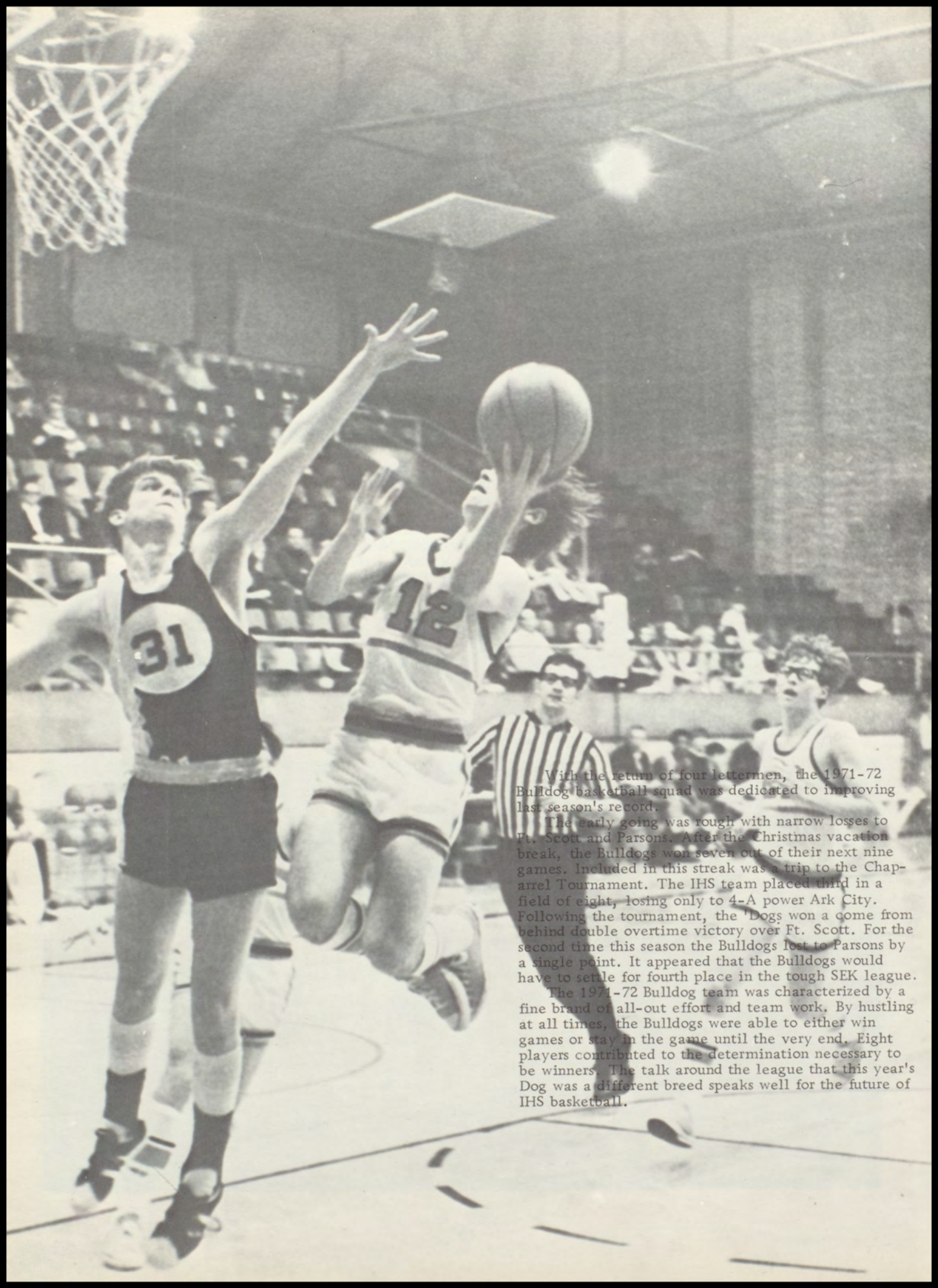

HARD-HITTING DEFENSE CAUSES FUMBLE IN ALTAMONT GAME.

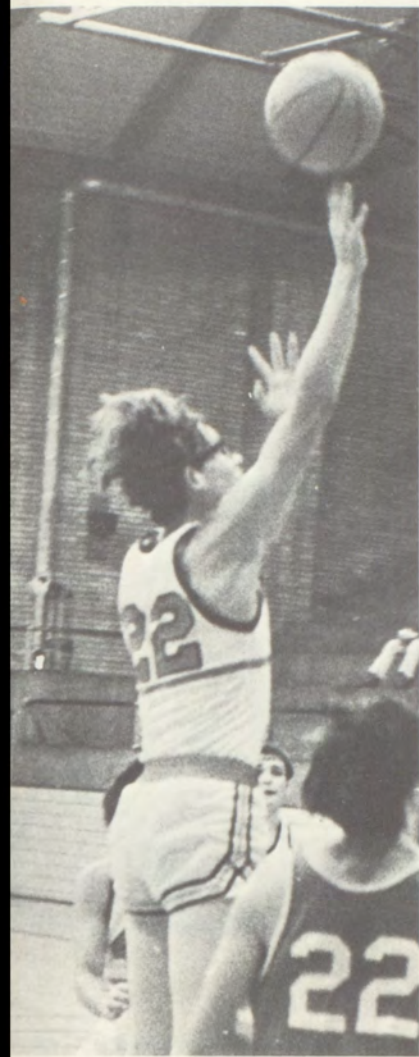




With the return of four lettermen, the 1971-72 Bulldog basketball squad was dedicated to improving last season's record.

The early going was rough with narrow losses to Ft. Scott and Parsons. After the Christmas vacation break, the Bulldogs won seven out of their next nine games. Included in this streak was a trip to the Chaparral Tournament. The IHS team placed third in a field of eight, losing only to 4-A power Ark City. Following the tournament, the 'Dogs won a come from behind double overtime victory over Ft. Scott. For the second time this season the Bulldogs lost to Parsons by a single point. It appeared that the Bulldogs would have to settle for fourth place in the tough SEK league.

The 1971-72 Bulldog team was characterized by a fine brand of all-out effort and team work. By hustling at all times, the Bulldogs were able to either win games or stay in the game until the very end. Eight players contributed to the determination necessary to be winners. The talk around the league that this year's Dog was a different breed speaks well for the future of IHS basketball.



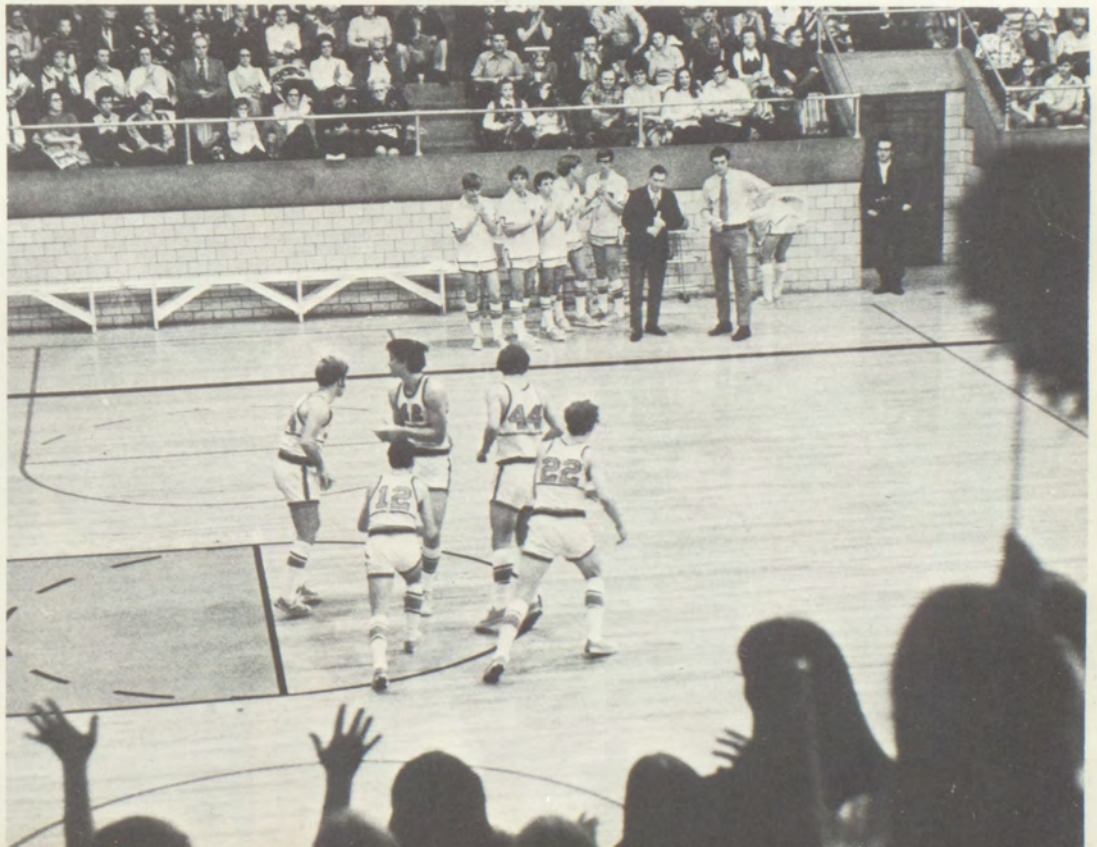

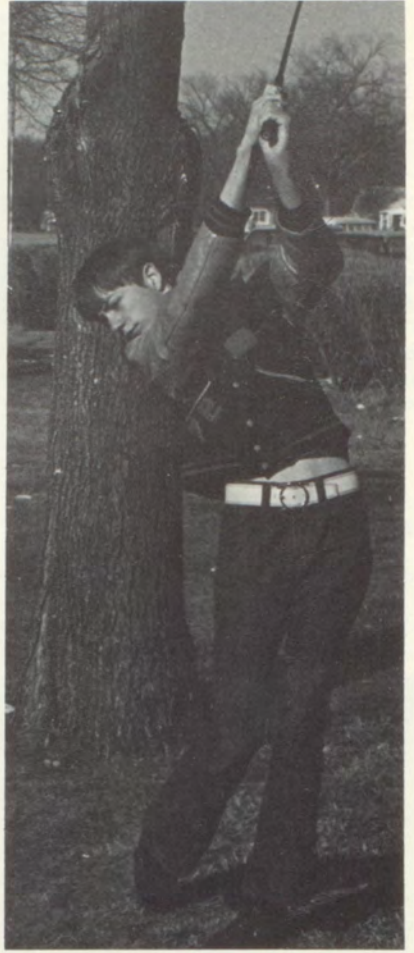

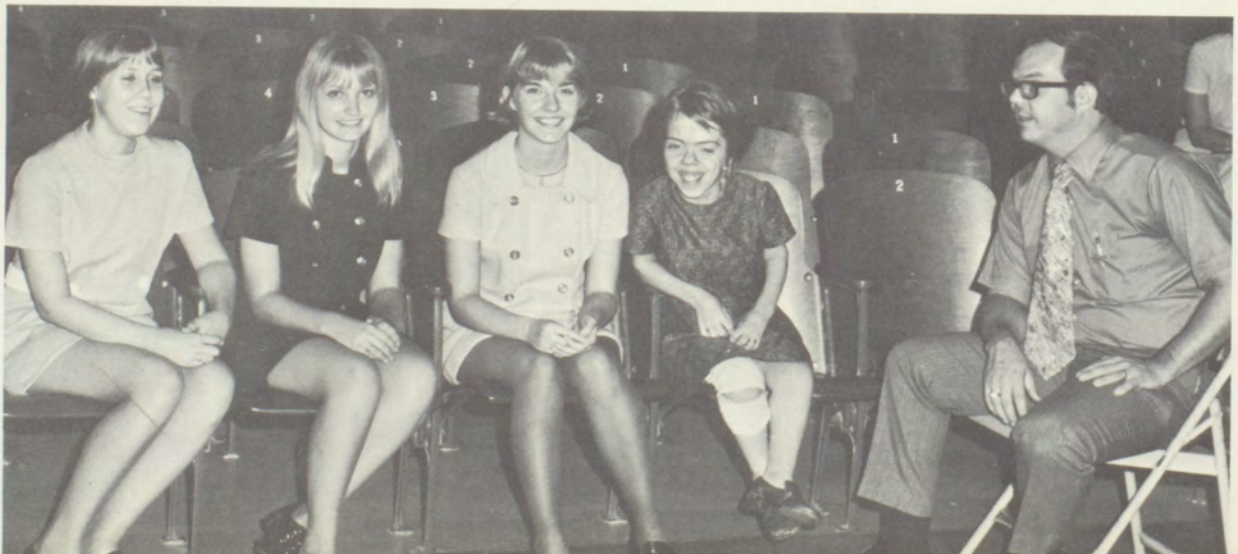

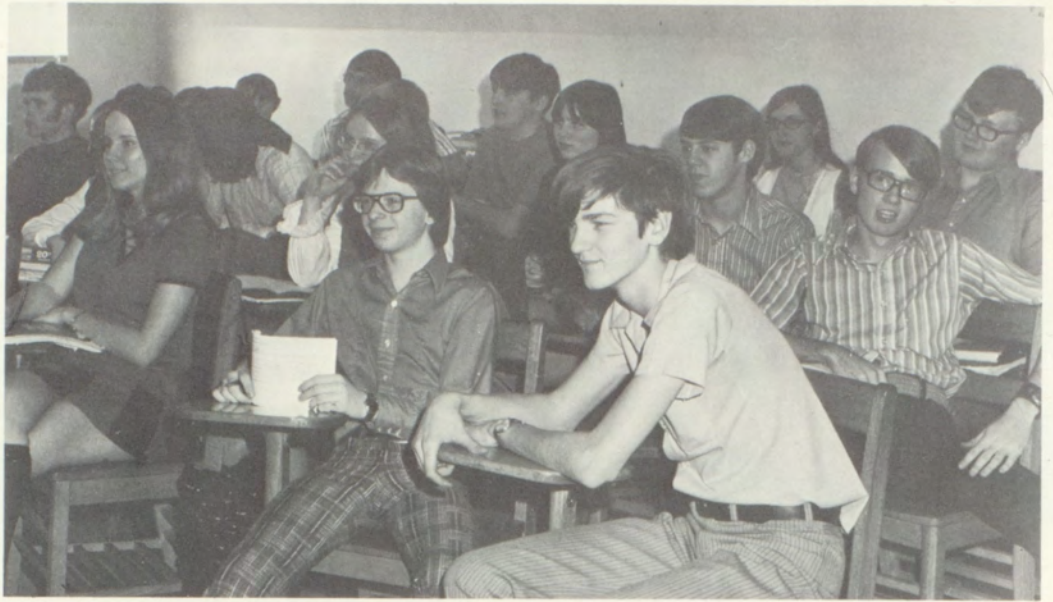

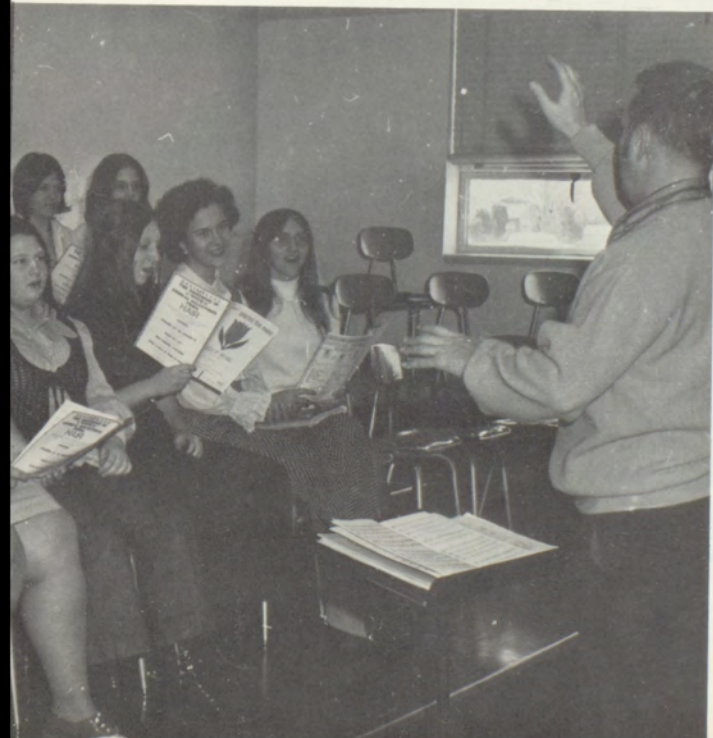
