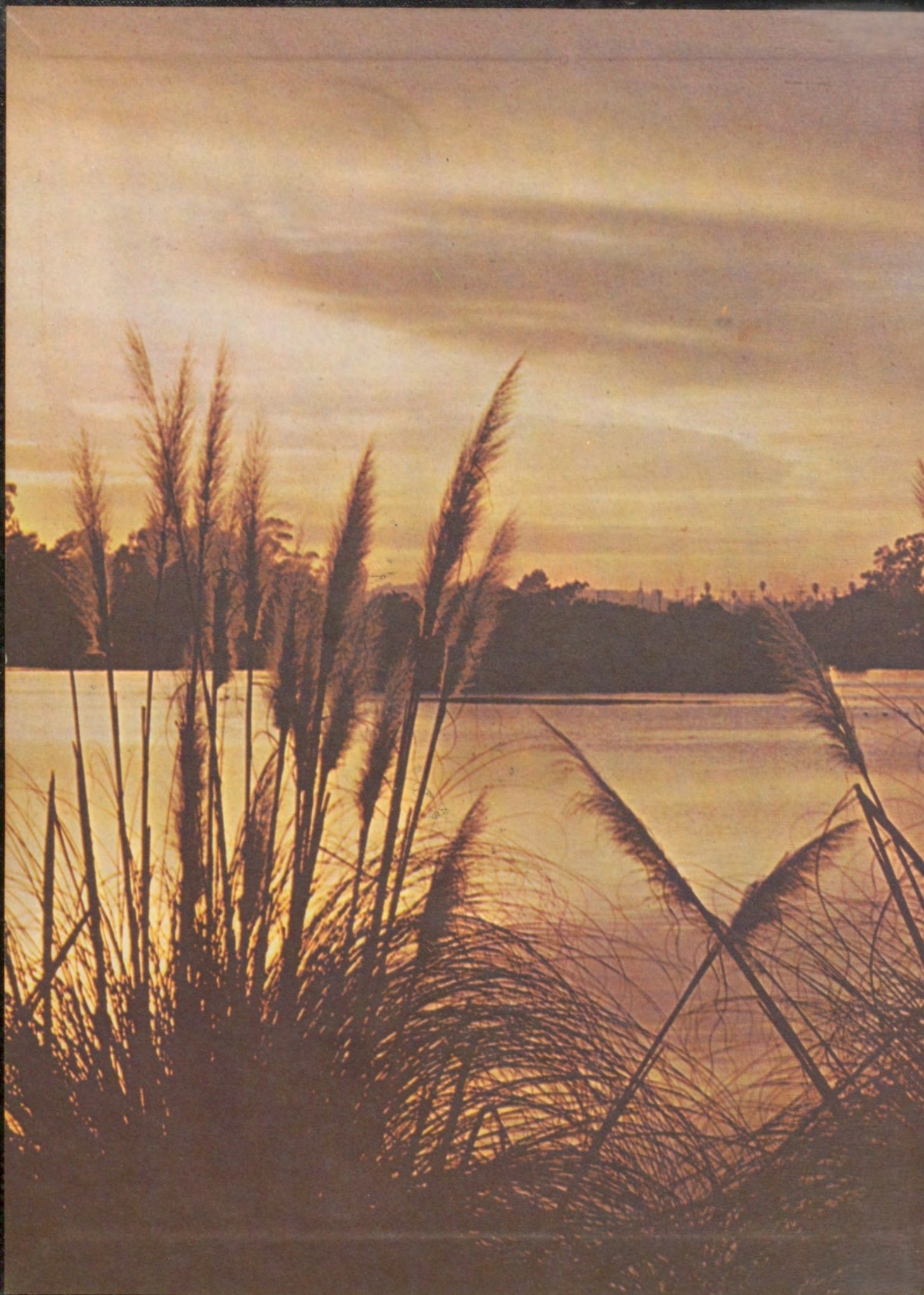
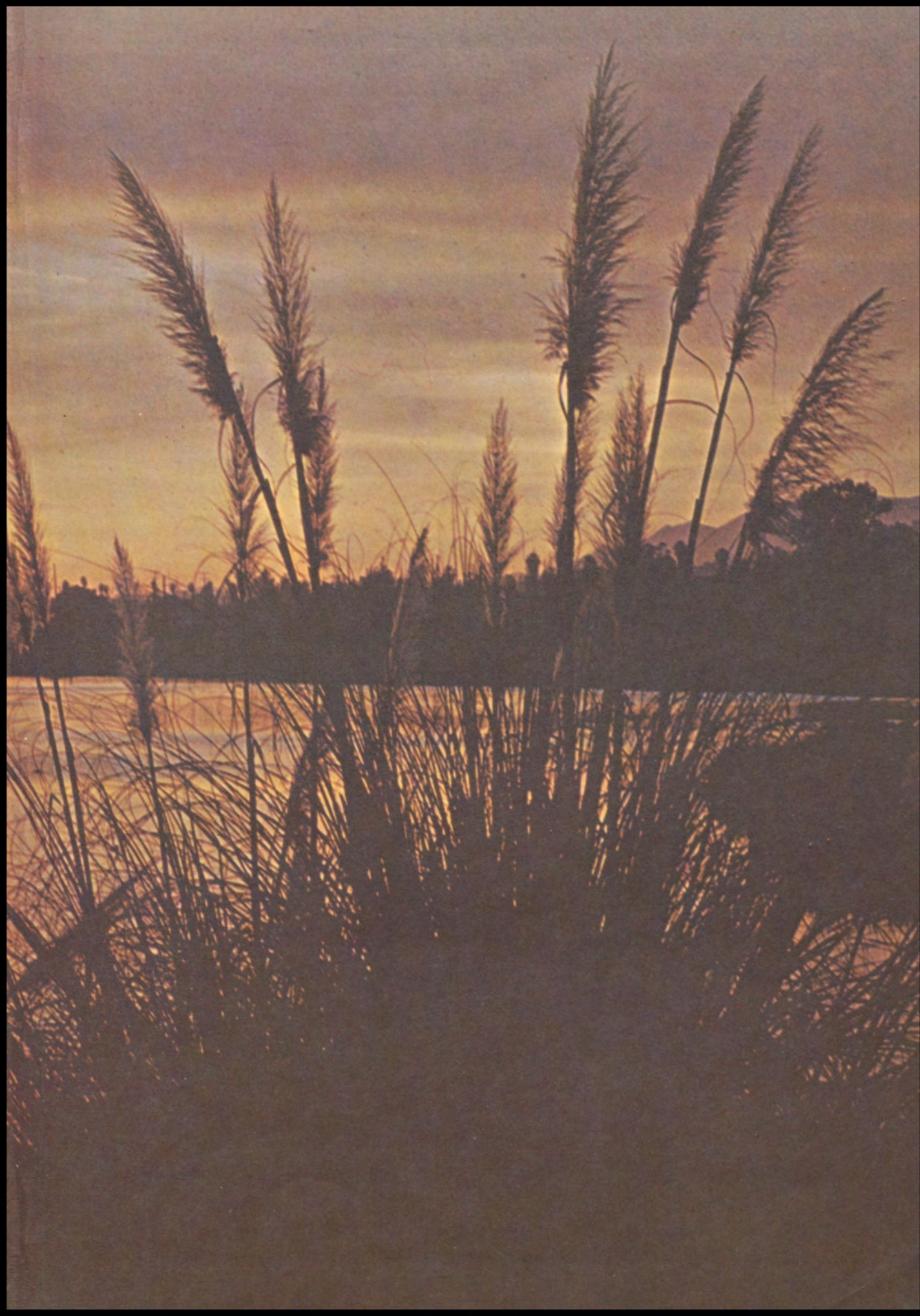


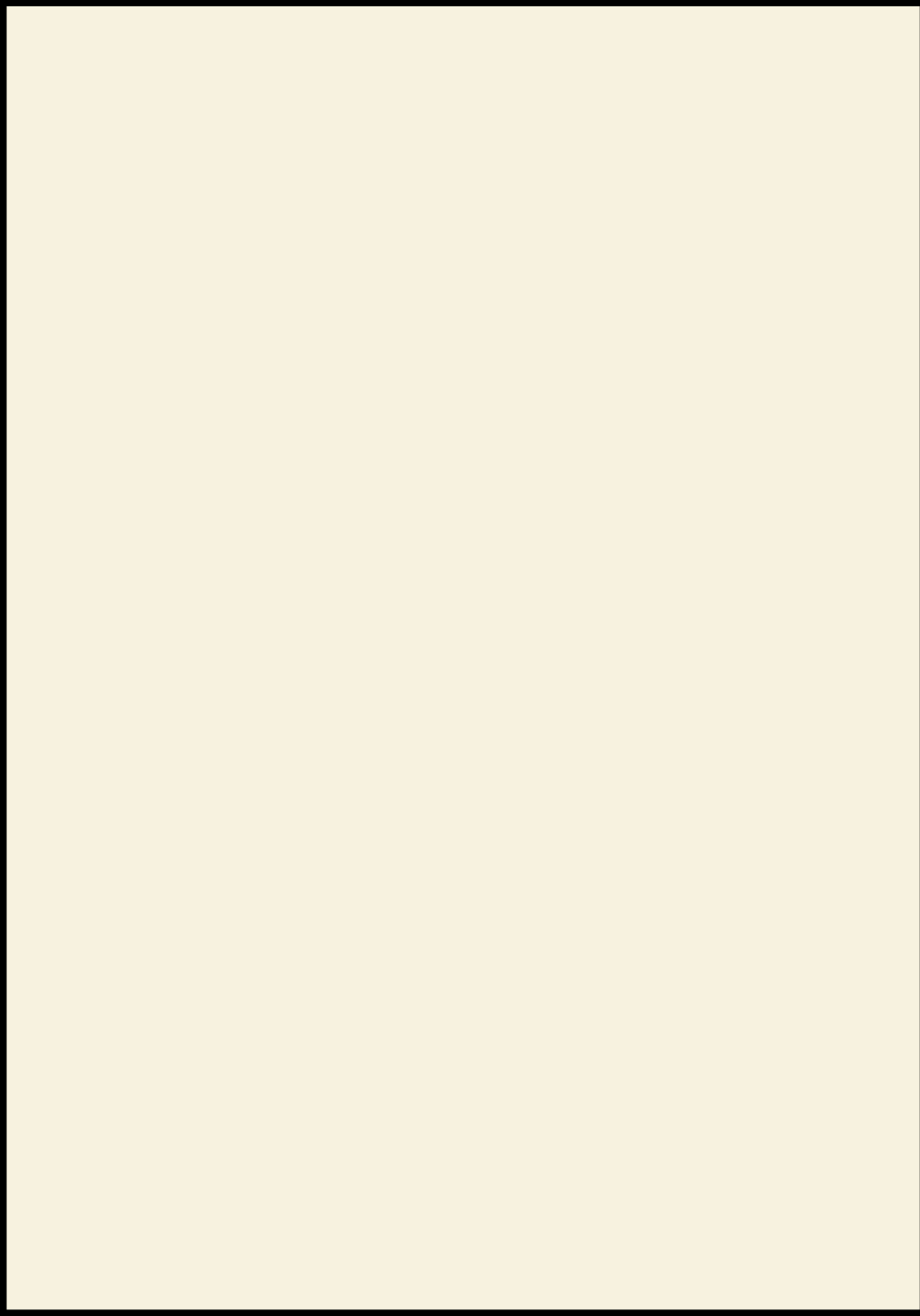

Mrs. Pauline Winn Smith

It would be difficult to find a person more dedicated to the cause of the teaching profession than Pauline Winn Smith.

After retiring from continuous teaching since 1911 in public schools, the Bible School was in need of her service. She has been with us, with the exception of one year, since 1960; teaching one term in the Upper Grades, and the rest of the time in the Departments of Commerce and English. Her qualifications as librarian have helped us to maintain accreditation in the high school for the past several years.

Mrs. Smith, mother of two successful sons, recieved both her B.S. and M.S. degrees from Pittsburg State College. In 1965 she was named to "Who's Who" of American Women. One of her sons is also listed in "Who's Who" in America. Always active in her community, Mrs. Smith has for some time been the Southeast District Director of the D.A.R., and is now on the Board of Directors of the Montgomery County Historical Society.

Letters come to her from former students scattered around the world. They have come, as we do here, to respect her firm stand for decent living, and a proper sense of humor mingled with stern discipline. This accounts in part for having made Mrs. Smith an outstanding teacher.

In recent years she has traveled to Alaska, Mexico, the Hawaiian Islands, and the Bahamas. Now she is considering a visit to the Holy Land.

Her example may serve to remind us that, "We too can make our lives sublime, and, departing, leave behind us footprints in the sands of time."

We here at the Independence Bible College are happy to have the privilege of dedicating this 1967 "Lantern" to the honor of Mrs. Pauline Smith.
