MR. FRED SUTTER

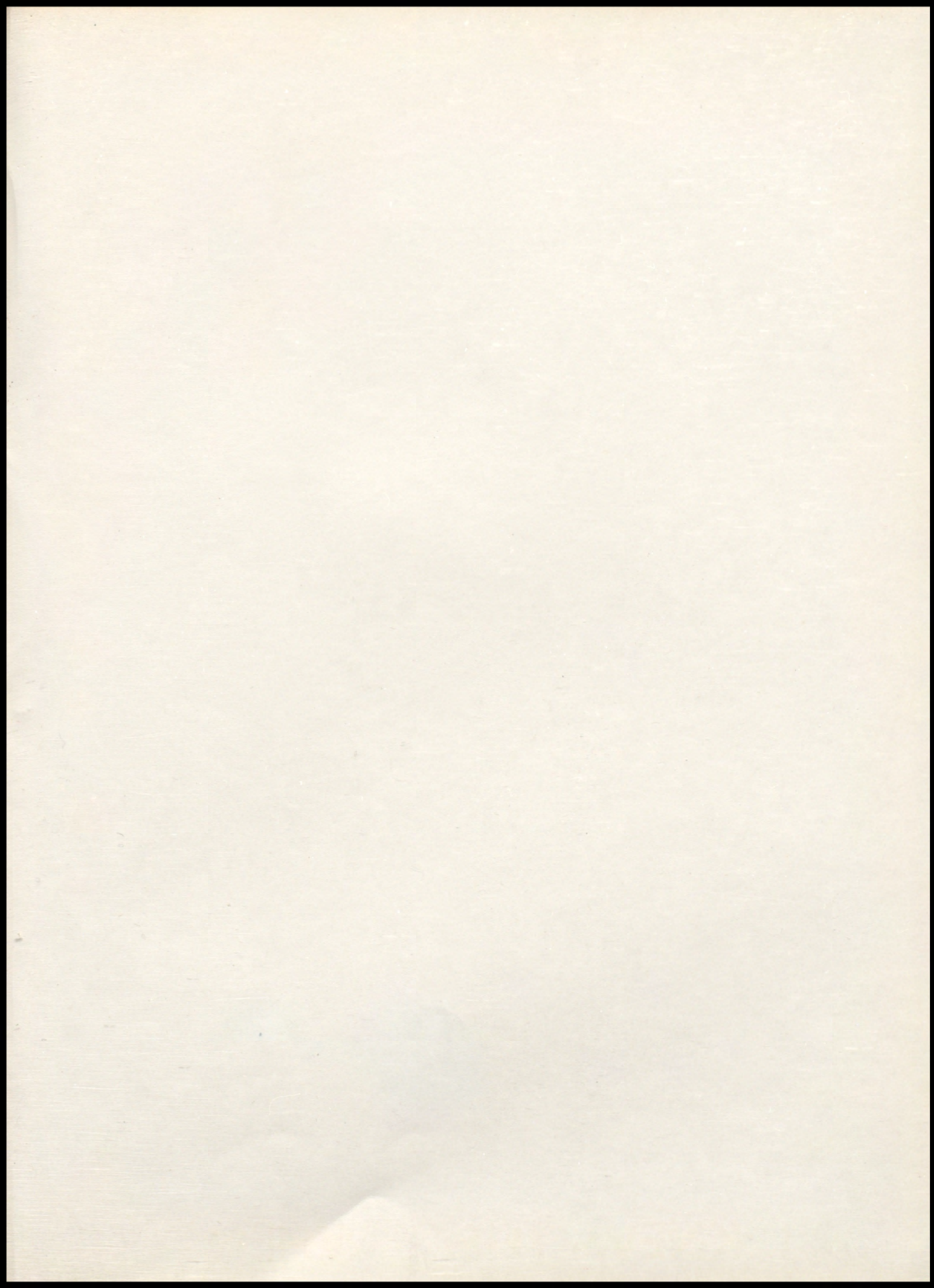
On Sunday, January 12, 1958, a rocket designed and constructed by David Sicks and Fred Sutter zoomed to the height of almost two miles at the Independence Municipal Airport before a dozen onlookers. The two boys, soliciting advice from engineers and other experts, had been working on the project for several weeks.

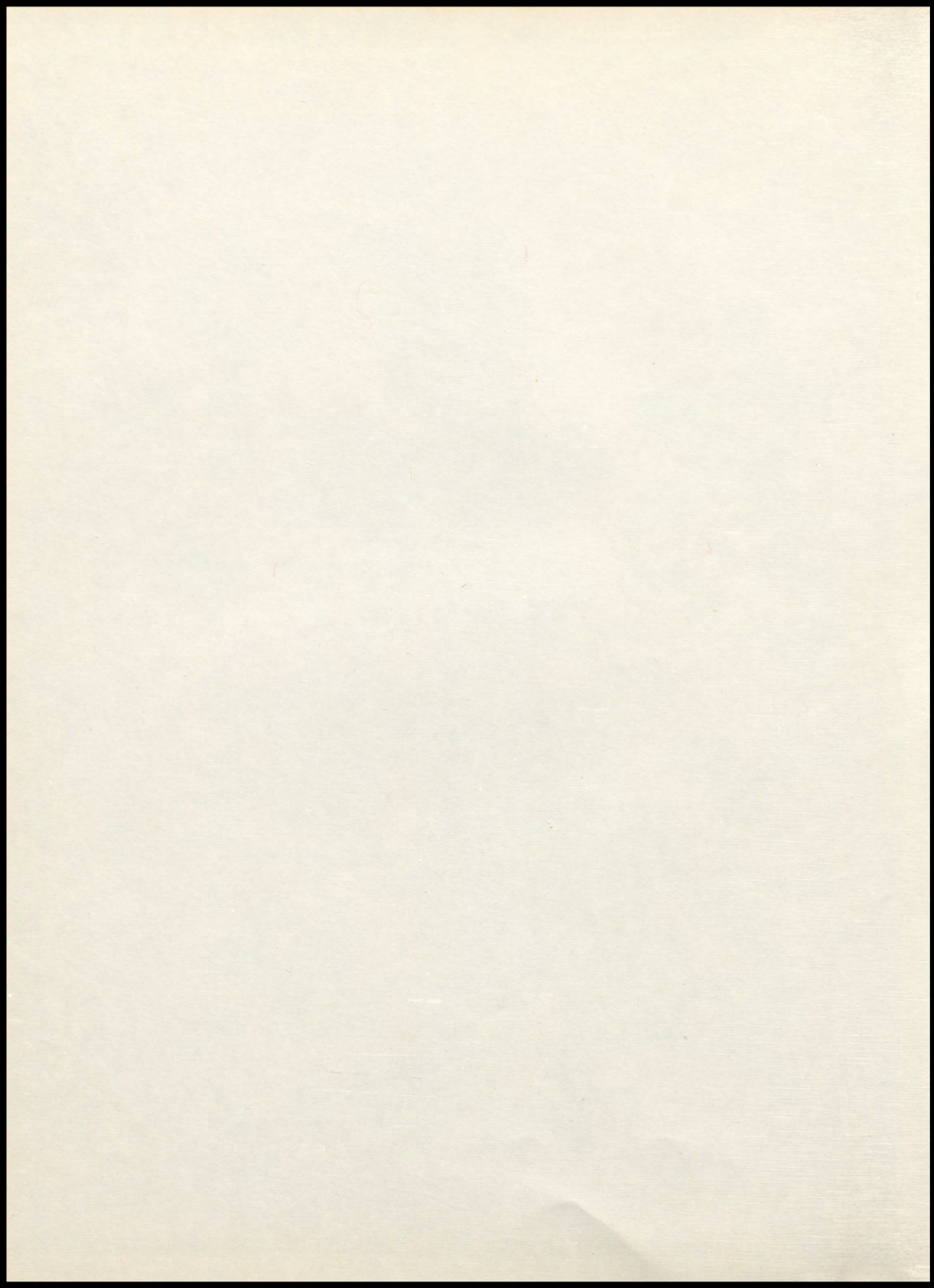
The six foot long projectile weighed 25 pounds 7 ounces when it was placed in position and the weight included 15 pounds 9 ounces of fuel. The fuel was 7 1/2 per cent zinc dust and 25 per cent sulphur and was ignited by a common dynamite fuse. It was figured that the projectile zooming skyward at an 86 degree angle had been in the air 48 seconds. An engineer said it fell from the peak of its flight at 27 seconds and using this figure calculated it reached a height of 11,722.33 feet before losing its thrust. At takeoff it was estimated that the rocket was traveling at more than 600 miles per hour.

The plume of yellow smoke was all the photographer could catch as the rocket was fired. The picture, along with an article, appeared in over two hundred newspapers around the United States. Among them were papers from Topeka, Tulsa, Wichita, Kansas City, St. Louis, Chicago, Phoenix, and Rochester, N. Y.

We are all very proud of David and Fred's fine work, and we wish them continued success in the field of science.

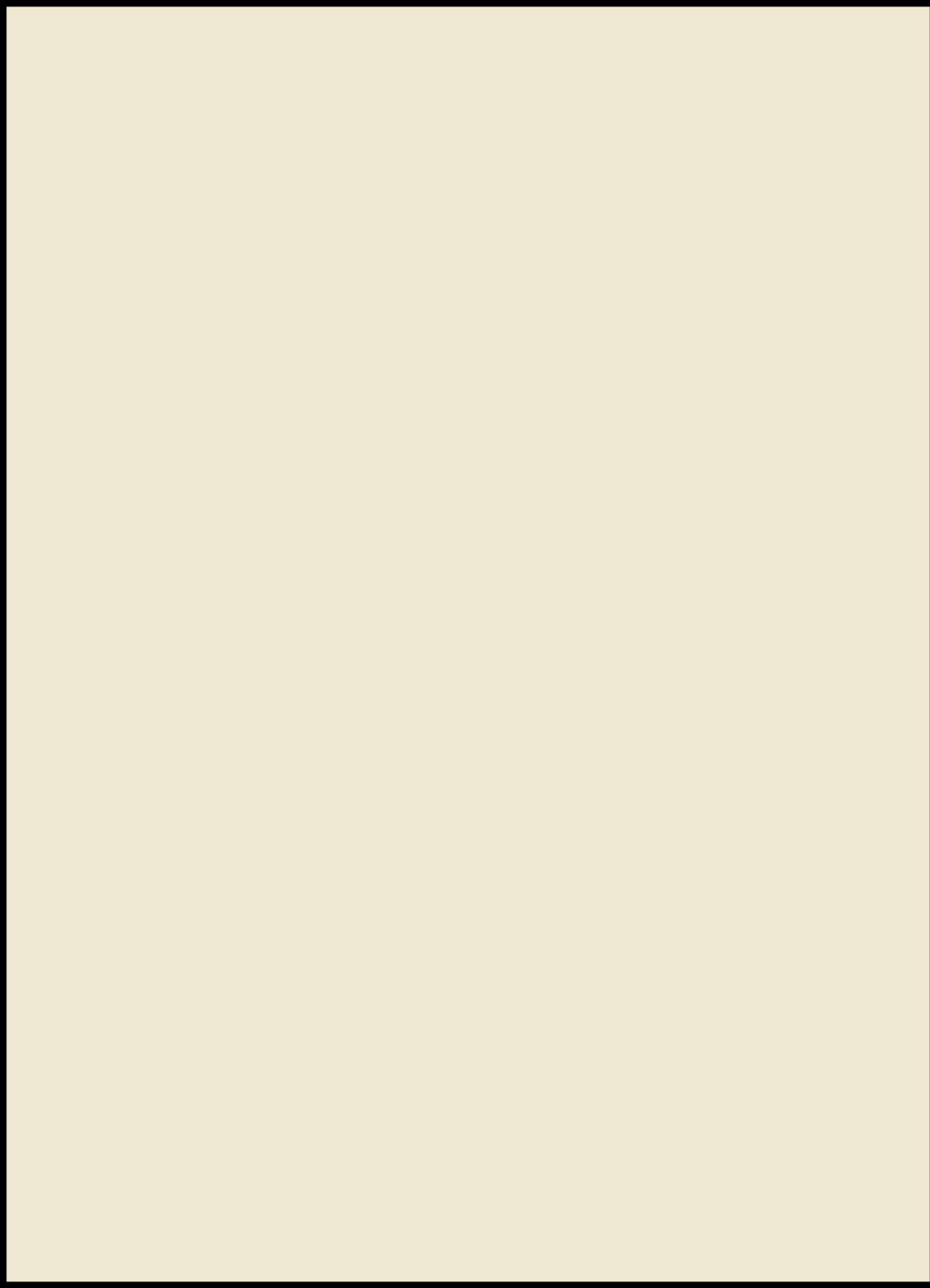


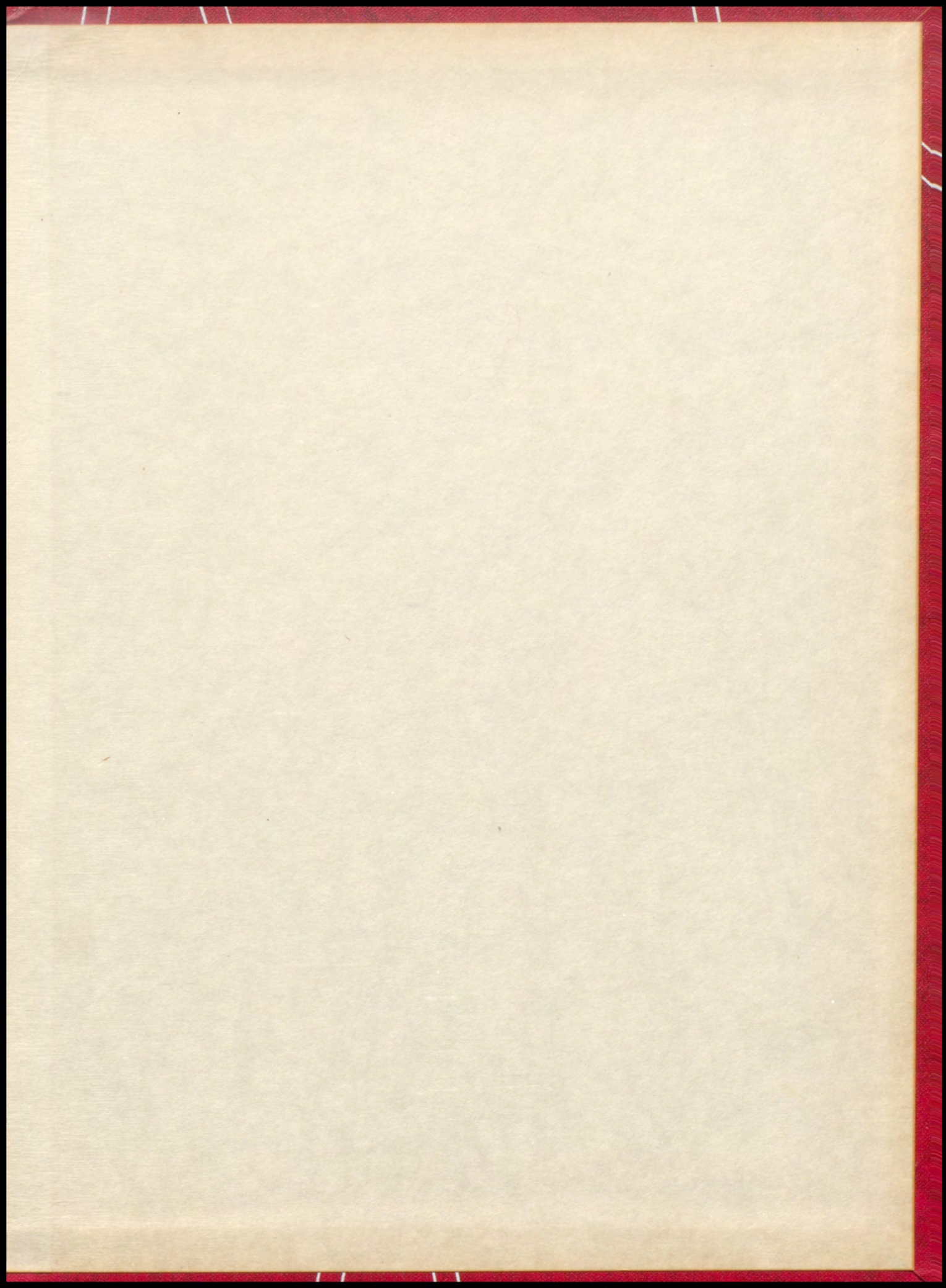
